LET US COUNT OUR BLESSINGS

This week starts our school year, with students returning for their first day of classes. Wow, how the time flies when you are having fun. This summer whizzed by for Fr. Jake and me - we can't believe we are getting back into the swing of things already. At the same time, however, we have been out and about with lots of adventures over the past couple of months. Fr. Jake joined the young men in Fraternus on their summer camp retreat for five days, and I did the same for the young ladies of Fidelis. We both got some vacation away, including a camping and biking trips for me and my little brother's wedding in Colorado. (Fr. Jake's brother is being married this fall as well!) Fr. Jake loves his water skiing and has enjoyed opportunities to do that.

There was a lot of fun closer to home as well. We had a great week of Vacation Bible School. We both were able to attend some of the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis. We spent time with parishioners at weddings, graduation parties, birthday parties, and lake days (perhaps our favorite!). We had our Family Adoration events in June and July (and already for August) which have continued to grow. (Kona Ice afterwards drew the largest crowd!)

There will also be a blessing of the new Stations of the Cross in the St. Joseph Garden.


