RCIA is a process meant to focus on faith development and growing in your relationship with God.

Consider RCIA if you are:

- An unbaptized adult
- A baptized non-Catholic adult who wishes to learn more about the Catholic Church
- A baptized Catholic who has not celebrated the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist (Communion)

SetonFest is arriving soon! Please plan to attend on the evening of September 7th starting after the 4:00pm Mass (30 mins. earlier than normal!). The team has been working hard all year, and many more volunteers are needed to make it successful. Please check the sheets posted in the gathering space to see how you may contribute to this wonderful community event!

The National Eucharistic Revival, which has begun its third and final year, had its most emphatic moment in July. The National Eucharistic Congress was five days of profound transformation, meant not only for the over 50,000 pilgrims who were there throughout those days, but for the entire Church in the United States. You can experience this congress, the first for our country in over forty years, at their website. If you create an account, you can watch the large events for free. Or you can purchase the entire congress, including all the breakout sessions, for \$99. Just go to this link to learn more: https:// www.eucharisticcongress.org/ streaming

There is another way to watch some of the congress. On Youtube, EWTN has a number of the more prominent talks available. I would recommend watching Sr. Josephine Garrett on healing, Jonathan Roumie's dramatic reading of John 6, and Chris Stefanick's talk (just 20 minutes long). Perhaps listening to one every day or two would be a good supplement to your own meditation and prayer, and strengthen your zeal for the Lord's True Presence in the Eucharist. God wants to build up His Church through this moment of Eucharistic Revival, and the first and most important part of that is what He wants to do in our hearts. Then. through our renewed and transformed lives, God will reach new hearts with His healing love.

In the Eucharist the Incarnation is made present anew: Jesus, the Word, becomes flesh and dwells among us! Let us allow the Blessed Mother to show us how to receive the Word of God in our souls as she lovingly welcomed the Word made flesh in her womb. May our lives be centered around and dedicated to the Word made flesh in the Eucharist!

TO OUR PARISHIONERS

Hello parishioner's, we want to let you know that we have opened the Mass Intention's from January through June of 2025.

There are 2 ways for you to access the Masses. You can either stop by the office to request a Mass or go to our website, seasfw.org and click on the title "Resources" found on the top ribbon. If you scroll halfway down, you will see "Mass Intentions Request". Simply click on it and it will open to show all available Masses (blue/green tabs). After you choose a Mass/Masses, It's set-up to walk you through the payment process.

Please note that you may only purchase 10 Masses per household per year. This will allow more families to have a chance to have Masses said for there living or deceased family members.

LITURGICAL MINISTER TRAINING



Two 6-Week Sessions on Saint Peter


You are invited to join our Bible Study on Saint Peter. Saint Peter is both inspiring and confounding to many of us. How could a
