KEEP YOUR FLAME ALIVE

SetonFest is only a couple Sundays away. Please consider how you can help contribute to the fun and memories that our parish family shares together each year. Now that youth formation and RCIA (newly renamed OCIA, Order of Christian Initiation of Adults) are getting started, we are really experiencing the full-speed rhythm of parish life once again. Within the abundant life of our parish family are so many ways to participate. That life that God offers us is found in community. When Jesus draws us to Himself, He draws us into the Body of Christ. Every Christian should have a life within the parish community. But at the same time, their life should not be only within the parish community. Saint Paul says we are called to be "in the world, but not of it." To be in the world, we cannot run away from it - spending every bit of our free time here at church within its walls and in the "church bubble" or "family bubble": even Fr. Jake goes to the Y to workout! But to not be "of the world," we must also draw our identity from the Lord and from His Church, as active members of the parish. So our connection to the parish needs to be more than just the 1-hour Sunday obligation. How am I an active member of the body of Christ, receiving and contributing to the life of the body, to something outside of myself and greater than just myself?

In a campfire, a log maintains its fire by remaining with the other logs that have the same fire: they keep the flame alive for each other. When separated, the fire goes out. The burning log becomes a clump of glowing embers, until eventually those too grow dim. We need to keep the flame of the spirit alive together, so that the burning charity of God's love remains hot in our hearts. We only have something to share with the world if we remain in the community of faith. "A dead thing can go with the stream; but only a living thing can go against it." (G.K. Chesterton)

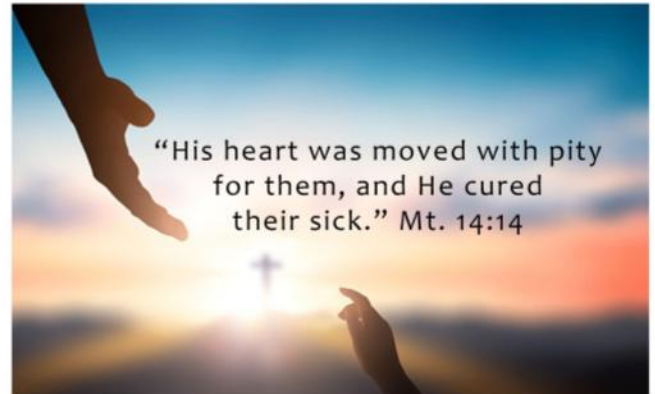

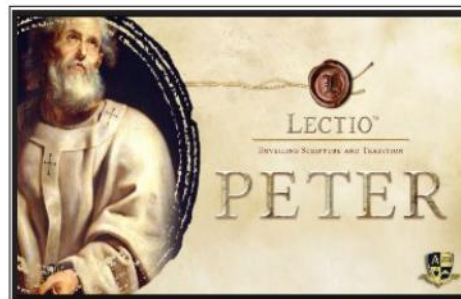

Two 6-Week Sessions on Saint Peter

You are invited to join our Bible Study on Saint Peter. Saint Peter is both inspiring and confounding

to many of us. How could a stubborn and impulsive fisherman become the rock upon which Jesus would build His Church?
