It is not a small undertaking in the least, and without their efforts to lay the groundwork, we wouldn't be able to accomplish this event no matter how many volunteers were willing to participate on the day of the event. It is a great accomplishment each year that should be appreciated, especially because just a few years ago this event was sadly absent from our parish life. 


