

#### I THANK GOD FOR BEING YOUR PASTOR

We had a great parish festival once again! One parishioner said they think there were more parishioners than in over a decade. Wow! I think that is a testament to the continued improvement of the event over recent years as we restarted this once-a-year event after a couple years off.

I wish to thank our Committee once again for all they have done. Every one of them spent a good amount of time preparing for this, spread out over months, but especially in the past week. I'm sure they were tired come Sunday morning / afternoon, but I know it was a labor of love for them, and very rewarding. I know that I was tired by the end of the night, too, perhaps because I was a little chilly outside, or perhaps because I did spend a number of hours helping that day, including set-up, running one of the kid's games, and clearing up tables and chairs after fireworks.

I slept extra hard that Sunday night after the weekend Masses were finished. And I woke up with a lot of gratitude in my heart for all the good people that our parish community comprises. This parish is a great joy and a gift to be a part of. I thank God for being your pastor, and I wish to see us continue to thrive as the Body of Christ week after week in Sunday Mass and in the many important ministries that we carry out together. There are two indispensable aspects of the Christian life: the "domestic church" of the home/family, and the "local church" of the parish. If we are not breathing with these "two lungs" of the Church, we will not be filled with the Spirit. May God continue to strengthen our homes and our parish so that we thrive as One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church in the world today.

With the Annual Bishop's Appeal this weekend, we also are called to remember the next level of our affiliation in the universal Church: the diocese. Fort Wayne-South Bend, under the leadership of Bishop Kevin C. Rhoades, has been a thriving people of God in our local territory of Northeast Indiana. It is supported most importantly by the donations given by the faithful each year in this Bishop's Appeal. Without diocesan staff and programs, our parishes would not be able to function well. Except for maybe Sunday Mass, we could say that almost everything we do as a parish has a touchpoint to the staff that are supported by the Annual Bishop's Appeal: religious education, RCIA, marriages, annulments, schools, and many charitable works. Another important part of the diocesan budget is to support retired priests and "priests-intraining" (seminarians). I look forward with expectation to see two men ordained to priesthood next summer, God-willing, who were former students of Saint Joseph High School in South Bend during my "tenure" as priest chaplain (which actually lasted exactly ten years). While seeds of priesthood are planted in the home, they are cultivated and pruned in the seminary, which has costs comparable to undergraduate colleges. Although many of the benefits are not seen directly, I assure you that the Annual Bishop's Appeal is indeed a blessing, and an essential one, for all of us. Please consider how the Lord is inviting you to support the work of our diocese, which ultimately makes all our parishes stronger.
