PHASE 2 SURVEY RESULTS IN SUMMARY

Lwant to provide a summary of our parish survey. Firstly, I wish to thank those who offered their input. Without engaged and committed parishioners, this survey would not have been very helpful. But the many who contributed (about 350 responses) gave a good insight into the perspectives of our parish.

The survey data was compiled and I led the parish council members in a discussion over the responses. We read every comment ourselves and then started to have a discussion over the information they contained. The parish council noted many good ideas from your comments that are worthy of consideration.

So now I will offer some of the more common input we received from the survey. The parish council noted that a majority of responses were in favor of phase 2 renovations. Even more replied favorably to the second question, of whether they would be willing to contribute to a fundraising campaign to implement the ideas of phase 2 for our church. They saw the results as not a "mandate" to proceed, but that parishioners are overall in favor of it.

Among the cautious or unfavorable responses, many mentioned financial concerns: the instability of our economy and/or their personal financial situation made them wary of the idea of a campaign, whether for themselves personally or for the parish community. Multiple others expressed timing concerns: some say it is too early, for two main reasons: it is tiring to be "under construction" all the time, or there is financial drain on many parishioners because the last campaign was under ten years ago. (In contrast, others responded we should do it now for two main reasons: out of enthusiasm for the project and momentum from phase 1, or due to continued rising construction costs that would only increase with inflation.)

A significant number of the responses seemed to focus only on the choir loft and not the other significant parts of phase 2 (return of the organ, extra meeting room, modified narthex, bell tower, finished pews in current choir area). Many said they don't see the choir enough to merit the need for a loft, and a few said they prefer the choir where they are and not using a loft. Some people mentioned comments about the music selection or quality. Some people said they missed the organ and want to hear it more often. Some said the bells (or loft) might be too expensive to be worth it.

Outside of the survey itself, the parish council noted how many parishioners mentioned their appreciation of how Phase 1 has improved our sanctuary, some of them starting out as skeptical but now are impressed by the results. We've also heard so many grateful for the improved clarity of sound in the church.

The parish council also mentioned it is important to remind people that Phase 2 is an integral part of Phase 1 of our church renovations. The original plans did include all of these improvements, but the cost was a factor that encouraged us to split the project into two parts and start with the "front and center" part of the project. Phase 2 is still meant to enhance our experience of worship, and Phase 1 is incomplete without it. The first and most important part of that is the organ. The other aspects also support the liturgy, but are lower impact to our worship, and are more oriented toward both community and evangelization.

This should be explained in depth, and a bulletin article will not suffice. So I am going to plan on a presentation for the parish on the phase 2 part of the project to help with that. Keep your eyes and ears open for when that will be.


SPIRITUAL ADOPTION THANK YOU






