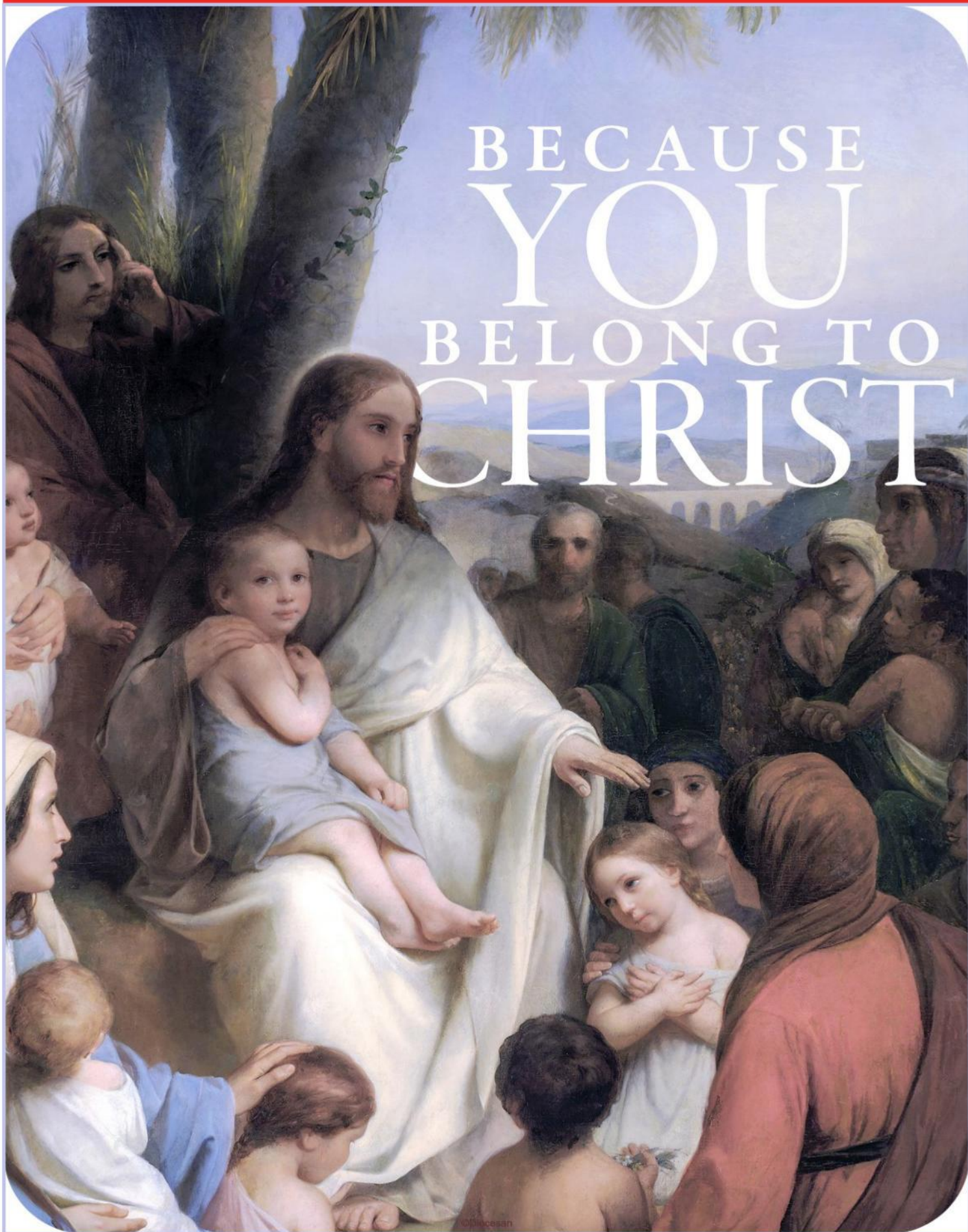

THERE ARE MANY WAYS TO GROW CLOSER TO THE LORD

It is important for us to set aside time for our relationships. A little bit of family-time each day should be a goal, even if not always looking the same from day to day: dinner together, night prayers, going to an event together. Spouses should try to have a chance each day to have some quiet time together, and perhaps a dedicated "date night" each month. We should try to visit our family if they are close, or connect over the telephone or write a letter. All of our human relationships need dedicated time and attention.

The same is true for our relationship with the Lord. A week ago the Fraternus men and mentors set aside some time especially for the Lord with their Fall excursion, and soon the Fidelis sisters are doing the same. They have some fun over those two days, but also have a lot of time carved out for the most important relationship in our lives, including prayers such as the Rosary, periods of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, and opportunities for Confession, along with Holy Mass, fulfilling their Sunday obligation to do what is "right and just": worshiping God for who He is and for all He blesses us with.

Adults have similar opportunities here in our parish and elsewhere. Four weeks from now is the women's Welcome Retreat, starting on Saturday Oct 26th. Two weeks later, Nov 9 & 10, the men's Welcome Retreat will be held. I encourage retreats of some form for us all, because we need to make time for the relationships that matter to us, and the Lord

should matter immensely to us. These retreats are great because they are held in our parish and organized by parishioners according to a trusted and fruitful format, but uniquely our own. If you can make yourself available those weekends (sacrificing other opportunities is something almost all of us have to do) then I encourage you to consider it. God is never outmatched in generosity. If you give God a weekend, you will reap dividends, I assure you, even if you don't notice it (like icebergs, a lot happens beneath the surface of our hearts)!

Along those lines, I want to thank you for your attention to the Annual Bishop's Appeal video a couple weeks ago, which I thought did a praiseworthy job of humble transparency for how the diocesan budget is allocated. This gives great assurance that our contributions to the appeal are important and impactful, bearing fruit in real ways through various ministries. Please discern with the Lord how He is directing you to support the appeal this year. If you haven't decided on a pledge yet, consider 1% of your annual income as a starting point of your discernment, and let God lead you from there. Generosity with God never goes unnoticed, even if the benefits are stored up for eternity. I think God usually gives spiritual rewards (fruits of the Holy Spirit and virtues) even in this life, but the gift should be given without such calculations and expectations. We give because we have received. We are stewards and are meant to use our goods in a way that would please God and be of benefit to others.

In 2023-2024, our parish began construction on phase one of the church renovation. Schenkel Construction, Design Collaborative, ASG, Sauder, Henningers, Graycraft Signs, Lupkin Designs, and Granda companies all contributed to the renovation of our sanctuary space. The front of the sanctuary was redesigned and a new, larger working Sacristy was added behind the altar area. A new altar and ambo were handmade from Italian marble. All new flooring was installed with marble tiles at the altar area, terrazzo tile along the front of the pews and down the main aisle, carpet under the pews, and laminate in the other aisles. A beautiful quote about the Eucharist was added as a wrap around the church. New lighting, new paint, the removal of the choir risers, and reconfiguration of the seating, has enhanced the worship space in this renovation. Three of the six new stained glass windows were installed by 6-30-2024. We eagerly await the final three windows and the paintings for behind the altar with installation to be completed in 2024-2025. Our school grew to 600 students registered in 2023-2024. Our youth programs increased in size, reaching more youth than ever (HIGH SEAS, Little Flowers, Scouts, Fidelis and Fraternus). Our Family Formation and Sacramental Prep programs continued to catechize both the student and the family. The Bible Study, Small Faith Groups, and Welcome groups met and grew the faith of the participants. SetonFest had another great year. Family Adoration nights and Healing Nights were added to help our families grow in their faith.

The Diocese assigned another priest, Fr LeeAllen Fortin, to our parish to focus on the hospitals and nursing facilities in our area.

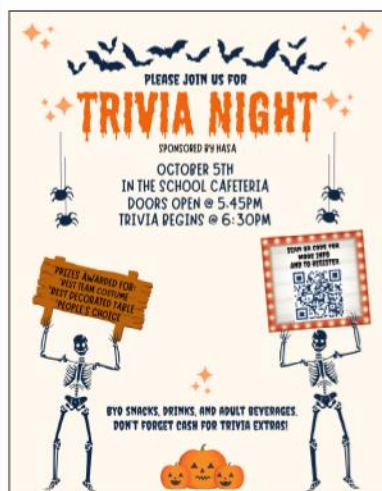


A Word From Our Principal:

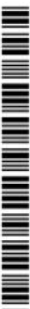
