PRAY FOR OUR BISHOPS AS THEY GATHER IN ROME

Many thanks to those who shared kind words and/or gifts to me as I celebrated entering into my forties. It was a beautiful reminder of how good God has been to me over the years. I don't deserve all I have received from Him, but at this point. We will have opportunity none of us ever has. God manifests His goodness by His abundant generosity - if small group discussion about the we have eyes to see it all. Thank you for your kindness. I renew my commitment to be a faithful servant-priest for all of you. May God continue to use me as He sees fit.

Next Sunday (13th) at 7:30 p.m. I will give a presentation about phase 2 of our renovations project. We will have this in the parish hall (if too large, we can use the church). This is an informational meeting, both for sharing and for gathering information. We have not begun implementation, but I do hope to move forward towards that. We do not have blueprints; we haven't even revisited the concept drawings that you see in the narthex (gathering space) showing the potential choir loft and a view of what the exterior could look like. (Those drawings are from 1.5yrs. ago)

We will discuss what has proceeded over the past two years in regards to these ideas, and the current location of where we are in the process. I will lay out my thoughts for where I expect things to go for clarifying questions as well as some church renovations (both phase 1 and phase 2).

Our bishop is away for the Synod at the Vatican. It is the most important ecclesial gathering that Pope Francis will hold this year for our church, and will last about one month with bishop representatives from around the world. As one of the few bishops from our country present, it is neat to know that our bishop carries us in our hearts to this important event. It truly shows how the church is united around the bishop of Rome, and how we are part of something greater than ourselves, even greater than our local diocese. I will be going away on vacation to Rome and hope to have dinner with Bishop Rhoades one of those evenings I am in the Eternal City.




