#### GOD EXISTS AND OUR HEARTS ARE MADE FOR **HIM**

Each year the priests of the diocese are summoned by the bishop to a program for continuing education. It is organized with his guidance and is meant to keep us in a growth mindset throughout the years of priesthood, engaging our minds and helping us to see from a different perspective some aspect of our priestly ministry or of the culture that we live in. It has been helpful for me over the years, and has many other benefits, including a real sense of priestly brotherhood. That aspect of collaboration is important for those priests who may be the only clergy within a large mile radius, such as former "son of Seton" Fr. Jay Horning, who is currently serving in Wabash, IN. Before Pentecost, as part of his own ministry of proclaiming the Kingdom, Jesus sent out the disciples two by two in their missionary work of "preparing the way" for Him. The pairs of disciples were a support to each other, much like a running buddy helps keep you going when your mind or body wavers temporarily. So it is really important that we priests take these two days each year to support each other as brothers in our work for the Lord and for His flock.

Because of this, we are going to have to miss some Masses this week. Please consult the Mass schedule to note that Wednesday and Thursday schedules are different.

Please keep in your prayers the upcoming Welcome retreats for Women (Oct. 26-7) and Men (Nov. 9-10). There is a good response so far but last I heard we still have spots available for the retreats. Fr. Jake said it well

last week: if you haven't been on a retreat for two or more years, you should work out some time for the Lord in a retreat such as this. While there are other opportunities, a parish retreat is a special blessing because you receive from your own community, and it is something you get to experience with fellow sisters or brothers in Christ from your own parish family. I will be making my own annual retreat next month (I missed the summer priest retreat the diocese provides) through a program that bishop commissioned me to go through. Fr. Fortin just had his own retreat through another program. It is an important opportunity for restoration of true spiritual health: to get back to the fullness of "reality" by putting our emphasis on what is most important: God exists, He alone is truly "real," and our hearts are made for Him and Him alone.

If you can't make a retreat this year due to commitments, here's another challenge: Can you spend ONE HOUR each week in quiet prayer in the church or chapel (open all hours via exterior entrance)? To sit with the red fire of the sanctuary lamp reminding you that Jesus is truly present - that is a great way to grow in intimacy with Jesus. If one hour is too much, how about 30 minutes three or more days a week in church or the chapel? I promise you, it will be hard for the first two or three visits, but then you will start to get comfortable and eventually will crave for that peaceful time with the Lord. Because you were made for Him and Him alone.




