MISSIONARY WORK IS ESSENTIAL TO THE UNIVERSAL CHURCH

This Sunday's 9:45am Mass welcomes those who are in the process of entering the church through the RCIA program (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults), which we will soon call by a new name, OCIA (the same basic format with some tweaks). These individuals have presented themselves to grow and learn about the faith while preparing to be an equal member of this parish family with us all – to be “new Catholics” through the ceremonies performed at the Easter Vigil. Some will need baptism – we call them “catechumens” at this stage of formation. Others are already baptized – we call them “candidates” (for full communion) – and they will receive Confirmation and First Eucharist at the Easter Vigil after they profess their full acceptance of the Catholic faith. This is the first of a number of ceremonies where they are introduced to the community and their progress is marked by these rituals. Please keep them in your prayers as they take this important step!

Next weekend we are invited to participate in the missionary work of the Church universal. While I am away for some vacation, Very Reverend Mark Gurtner, our bishop's vicar general, will come to help Fr. Jake with the weekend Masses, as well to explain the missionary work that our bishop has selected for our parish to support this year. He will speak on behalf of the newly-consecrated Bishop Don Wimal Siri Jayasuriya of the Diocese of Chilaw in Sri Lanka. This man

was serving as pastor of St. Mary's in Fort Wayne when he was appointed to this role by Pope Francis in early 2024. You can find an article in Today's Catholic about the appointment. While he was originally scheduled to give this appeal to our parish, for obvious reasons he is no longer able, and Fr. Gurtner will help us understand the needs of that growing diocese that is such a great distance from us. If you feel that Catholics are a minority in our community, you might be surprised to by their experience in Sri Lanka.

Just a month ago we were invited participate in the Annual Bishop's Appeal, a reminder that we are part of something larger than just our parish. Our “local church” is actually more concretely the diocese than it is the parish, since as pastor I am merely a co-worker under the bishop. With this upcoming missions appeal, we are invited to remember that our diocese is part of something even larger – a universal communion of bishops who have the same faith, the same Sacraments, and the same governance, in union with Pope Francis. As St. Paul says, “when one part of the body suffers, all suffer with it; when one part rejoices, all rejoice with it.” So may we provide for those brothers who are in need, and may their prayers and works of holiness strengthen us as well. This is the blessing of being part of the Communion of the Catholic Church!


