### BLESSED BE THE VIRGIN MARY, OUR MOTHER

The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is very important to the universal church, and to our country in particular. That importance is manifest in a special way this year. Since this Sunday falls on the feast day of December 8th, the Catholic Church across the globe will transfer the celebration to the next possible day, Monday. We simply will not let it be missed because of the importance of the Virgin Mary's role and vocation in the story of salvation that Christ obtained for us. Beyond just that, the Church in the United States is under the patronage of Our Lady by the title of the Immaculate Conception: Our National Shrine of the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C. stands as a clear testament to this truth, and is a place no one should neglect to visit at least once in their life if it is possible.

Since we take "the Immaculate Conception" as our patroness, this Solemnity on Monday is also a holy day of obligation for all of us in the United States. We are "obligated" (should we say "blessed"?) to attend Mass that day and celebrate our country's patroness. We will have four Masses that day at our parish. You may also wish to check other parish bulletins to see their Mass schedules if you will have difficulty attending here.

My friends from the Holy Land, Alfred and Grace Salsa, come with their handmade artifacts from the Christians (mostly Catholic) in Bethlehem and nearby areas. Your purchases of gifts or items for yourselves will help them to send proceeds back to the families who still live in the Holy Land and are drastically impacted by the conflict in Gaza and the West Bank (very few pilgrimages have occurred over the past 14 months, and the economy relies on them).

On Saturday the 14th, please come to a Lessons & Carols (prayer-focused choral performance) for Advent, led by the ECCE Young Adult Choir from our local area. Catholics of Northeast Indiana and Northwest Ohio form this amazing team of dedicated individuals who sacrifice to create beautiful music for the parishes in our local dioceses (us and Toledo). You will be thoroughly impressed by their talent and prayerfulness. Please try to carve out the time for a couple hours of quiet reflection in the often bustling Advent season.
