SAINT ELIZABETH ANN SETON-PRAY FOR US

This past August marked 250 years since the birthday of our patroness. This upcoming September will mark 50 years since her canonization. Elizabeth Ann Seton was declared a saint on September 14th, 1975 by Pope Paul VI (also now a Saint!).

To mark this "golden anniversary" of our saint, we wish to spend the year of 2025 celebrating our great patroness who was once known simply as "Betty Bailey." As a parish staff, we have had a couple brainstorming sessions to think about what we can do. Honestly, the possibilities seem endless for how as a community to honor our patroness and unite in praising God for her life of heroic virtue.

The feast day of our patroness will begin our celebrations, as we gather on Saturday January 4th for a Christmas concert with our parish choir and have a reception to follow. It is hoped that we will have a special event every month for the remainder of the year, maybe on the 4th of the month or nearby when necessary (for example, for July).

In order to organize these special events and other ideas, we want to create a special steering committee for these efforts. This would require a lot of time up front in the planning, logistics, and collaborating with various parish groups, hopefully finishing the majority of the planning before March. After that time, it would mostly be coordinating the implementation of whatever the group comes up with for the parish community.

If you are someone who:

- 1. has the ability to help plan and collaborate,
- 2. the time to devote to this for the next year, especially January and February,

and a passion for the parish and our patroness, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, then please let the parish office know you want to be a part of the steering committee. We will look to have an introductory meeting in January after these holidays. Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton, pray for us!



Two Hours + Sunday Driving = Being Christ in Someone's Life. Several community partners (Rescue Mission, Just Neighbors, recently reached out to the St. Vincent de Paul Society to see if we could help transport families with children between locations on Sundays this winter through our transportation ministry. These families would otherwise be homeless and left out in the cold without emergency shelter. Since public transportation does not operate on Sundays, these families currently don't have a

way to get from the overnight shelter at Just Neighbors to the Rescue Mission to receive meals and a place to stay during the day. As a volunteer driver, you would either be driving one of our Care Van vehicles or a van provided by the Rescue Mission. No special driver's license or extra driver's training is required - just a clean driving record and a desire to help those in need. This is a very minimal time commitment (1 or 2 Sundays for a total of two hours each day) and perfect for those that have limited time or work during the week and would still like to help. It would only involve about an hour in the morning and another hour in the evening on a Sunday (sometime between December and March) to make a few trips between the locations. 

Are you interested in providing a gift to a child to assist them in attending Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic School?

Your gift to the Scholarship Granting Organization of Northeast Indiana (SGONEI) will enable the school to offer scholarships to qualified families of students in kindergarten through eighth grade. There is no limit on the size of the gift that can be made and any individual or business can make a gift. Additionally, if you desire, your gift to the SGONEI can be restricted to the students of Saint Elizabeth.

Your donation is a WIN-WIN for everyone. SGO scholarships help low/middle income families afford a Catholic education. In return, as a donor to the SGO, you will receive an Indiana state income tax credit equal to 50% of the amount of your gift; in addition, you may qualify for a federal tax deduction for donating to a 501(c)(3), subject to the rules of the tax law and IRS. The following table illustrates how this could work:

For the 2024-2025 school year, 206 students attending Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic School were awarded SGO scholarships to assist them with the cost of tuition. Your gift to our parish SGO scholarship fund will allow us to continue to award scholarships to our students that need financial assistance in future school years.

Donations for the calendar year 2024 should be made <u>before Christmas</u> in order to allow time for the SGONEI to request your tax credit number from the Indiana Department of Revenue (DOR). Any requests received by the DOR after December 31, 2024 will be applied to the 2025 tax year, even if the donation was made in 2024. **The SGONEI office will be closed December 24th, 25th and 31st.**
