Elizabeth Ann Seton was declared a saint on September 14th, 1975 by Pope Paul VI (also now a Saint!).

This would require a lot of time up front in the planning, logistics, and collaborating with various parish groups, hopefully finishing the majority of the planning before March ends. After that time, it would mostly be coordinating the implementation of whatever the group comes up with for the parish community.

would be a lot more effective with some
others to help coordinate the special events
and initiatives this team will dream up.


