THE TABLE GROUP

If you don't take care of your car despite miles and miles of use, it will end up pretty beat up and could be deeply damaged. This is why many of us get our vehicles cared for (or do so ourselves) to make sure they are running smoothly and optimally. The same fits in other aspects of life: your health gets at least an annual check-up; you go to the dentist regularly. Organizations, including parishes, need that kind of "maintenance" as well.

Our parish staff spent six hours last Saturday (the 11th) doing a workshop for organization clarity. Corporate consultant Pat Lencioni, founder of The Table Group, has adapted his work to support the Catholic Church, especially pastors and parishes. This organization is called Amazing Parish. You should check out their website and conference videos. I went to conference about eight years ago and found it very helpful for my parish. We have incorporated some of their work into the work of our staff here at Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton.

The goal of our meeting was to answer four questions of Lencioni's six "clarity questions." The goal of these questions is to get everyone, and everything, in the parish "aligned" with a unifying focus and direction so that we can maintain a strong identity, build momentum in the work we are about, and help us navigate the landscape as months and years progress. The first four questions are the foundational ones:

- 1 Why do we exist? (our purpose and mission)
- 2 How do we behave? (our core values; "personality" or "character traits")
- 3 What do we do? (our business definition to achieve the mission)
- 4 How will we succeed? (strategic anchors that keep us from fragmenting)

We got a solid draft completed through the workshop. Our working answers to these questions will help us as a parish staff to remain united and focused in the busy pace of parish life (including a flourishing school!). Below is a summary. Please pray for our parish, especially our staff, to live these well going forward!

- 1 We exist to be a bridge that brings God to our community, and our community to God.
- 2 We entrust ourselves to the will of God, we encounter Jesus in each person, and we radiate joyful hope.
- 3 Our parish prays together, administers the sacraments, strengthens community bonds, forms and sends disciples, and serves the poor (corporal and spiritual works of mercy).
- 4 We focus on parishioner engagement (especially contribution to community life), the sacramental life (deeper participation in Mass and the sacraments), and spiritual accompaniment (walking in faith with each other through mutual / group support).



COMING SOON: SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD

In 2019, Pope Francis established the *Sunday of the Word of God* to be celebrated each year on the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time. As the Holy Father stated in his apostolic letter instituting the observance, "Devoting a specific Sunday of the liturgical year to the word of God can enable the Church to experience anew how the risen Lord opens up for us the treasury of his word and enables us to proclaim its unfathomable riches before the world" (*Aperuit illus*, no. 2).

On January 26, 2025, in observance of the Sunday of the Word of God, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, through a grant from the American Bible Society, will offer a "Sunday Seminar Series" of six videos about Sacred Scripture in the life of the Church. These videos, available in English and Spanish, will feature some of the bishops and biblical scholars and will be accompanied by discussion/reflection questions.

Through these videos, we hope to bring people into an encounter with Scripture. May God's people be inspired and challenged to see, understand, and engage with


