

### FR. JAKE'S ARTICLE

# **Faithfully**

Yes, it is one of my favorite songs by Journey; but moreover, it is the word that has come up again and again in my prayers for this parish. It is the word that carries such a weight, for although it takes a few moments to dedicate your life to another person, whether it be a human person in marriage or the Mystical Body of Christ in sacred vocations; it is a lifetime of unfolding and proving. A transformative covenant, a seed, in hopes to grow and bloom one day bearing the fruit of the words of our loving Savior, "Well done, thy good and *faithful* servant."

This past weekend I attended the Worldwide Marriage Encounter, which helps couples build up their intimacy to reap greater fruit in their relationship. It was inspiring for me to hear the vulnerability of each of the lead couples; by entrusting a deeper part of themselves to their spouse they were able to build an even stronger bond, like "the joy of rediscovering you". Thus, teaching the other couples to imitate a similar behavior. I not only appreciated the tools for building a more intimate marriage, which I may recommend to other couples, but I have greater reverence for the sacredness of the martial covenant.

The sacrament of marriage is the visible sign of Christ's love for his bride, the Church. The more couples that are faithful to each other, the greater is the sign of Christ's love for the world. Our parish needs our faithfulness, our community needs our faithfulness, our culture needs our faithfulness. It communicates to the world that just as "I'm forever yours Faithfully," so even Christ is faithfully ours forever, never giving up on us, and willing to forgive any fault of our own to preserve the union of us to Him.

We have heard the distressing statistic that 50% of marriages last until death. Perhaps, those struggling couples are closer to us than we think – our neighbors, our pew mates, our coworkers, and our friends. We owe it to them to pray for the grace of Christ to bless their lives.

Will you pray this novena with me to lift those up who are struggling in marriage?

Dear Lord, we thank You and praise You for the gift of marriage.

We humbly ask You to pour out Your grace upon all marriages.

You have given us the sacrament of marriage so that husband and wife might be bound together sacramentally as they journey toward heaven together. But in our fallen world, many marriages struggle because of our faults and sins.

Help all couples to recognize their own failings and be reconciled to you and their spouse. We ask You to strengthen and bless all marriages, and we particularly ask today that You help all marriages that are struggling because of dishonesty.

Help us to always follow Your will for us in our lives, even when it is very difficult. Give us the grace to grow in the desire to please You more fully each day of our lives.

And we especially ask in this noven afor (mention your intentions here).

Lord, we make this prayer in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.





