## **40 HOURS TO ADORE HIM**

This year's 40 Hours devotion will begin at 6:30 p.m. on Sunday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> and continue until Tuesday night, with a reception to follow the end of our 40 Hours of continual Adoration of Our Eucharistic Lord Jesus. The three priests who will speak for each of those evening sessions (the same start time, 6:30p.m.) will certainly make it another beautiful event for our parish. But equally important will be the quiet times of prayer that we all will give to Christ inbetween those events. Your time of Adoration during 40 Hours is the best gift you can give to the Lord. He desires to speak to your heart during those times of quiet - and for those who are willing to interrupt their sleep to give special time in those late-night and earlymorning hours, I am sure you are in for an even more special treat.

We will have the Eucharist exposed throughout the three days, except during daily Mass on Monday at 6:30 am and 8:15 am and Tuesday at 8:15 am and 6:00 pm.

I invite all of our parishioners to commit to signing up for a specific hour to come and visit Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament since He cannot be left alone. If you are willing to go a step further, try coming more than once (or extending your first visit).

You may be wondering what "Eucharistic Adoration" is about, as it might be something new to your experience, or perhaps you aren't sure what to do during that time of quiet. Let me help with some short summaries to those basic questions. What do I do during Eucharistic Adoration? There is no wrong way to pray during adoration as long as you are respectful to God and to your neighbor. You could simply gaze at Jesus and allow Him to gaze at you. You can pray and meditate with scripture, perhaps

What is a holy hour? It is simply an hour spent with Jesus' True Presence in the Eucharist (whether in the tabernacle or exposed in the monstrance). This began as a devotion in response to Jesus's lament to his sleeping disciples in the Agony in the Garden: "Couldn't you men keep watch with me for one hour?" (Matthew 26:40). Though fully human, Jesus, as God, is not limited by time and space we can console Him in His sufferings in the garden by spending time praying with Him now in Eucharistic adoration.

What is Perpetual Adoration? This is a place for Eucharistic Adoration with exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the monstrance all day every day without ceasing. Two parishes in Fort Wayne have this available in designated chapels, and there is a religious order in Mishawaka of sisters who have been taking turns adoring our Lord in the Eucharist for decades nonstop.

What do I do during Eucharistic to pray during adoration as long as you are respectful to God and to your neighbor. You could simply gaze at Jesus and allow Him to gaze at you. You can pray and meditate with scripture, perhaps the Sunday readings, especially with the techniques of imaginative meditation or "lectio divina" (check Dynamic Catholic's short explanation online). You can pray formal prayers like the rosary, divine mercy chaplet, or litanies (there are so many!). Journal: write your prayer to Jesus about what's going on in life. Walk the stations of the cross. Talk to Jesus in your heart and ask Him to speak to you -He may give you a word or phrase or image or even just a sense of his consoling presence. Read spiritual books, many classics can be downloaded for free on a smart phone. Imagine placing before the monstrance your sins, your worries, your loved ones, the world, etc. Even listen to hymns or spiritual music using headphones/ ear pods (but try not to sing out loud for your neighbors!). And of course, you can do a combo of any of those things. Jesus deeply desires you to spend time with Him, so that He can tell you that He loves you.
