# WHAT A GIFT FOR EASTER TO HAVE OUR MURAL INSTALLATION COMPLETE!

You may not be able to tell which saints we are admiring in heaven, so here's a reminder: Mother Teresa of Kolkata (Calcutta) - (Albanian); Bl. Solanus Casey (Irish-American); Kateri Tekakwitha (Native American); Martin De Porres (half Spanish, ¼ African, ¼ Native American); Peter the Apostle (ancient Jewish); Elizabeth Ann Seton (Colonial Anglo-American); Jose Sanchez del Rio (Hispanic); Louis & Zelie Martin (French); Josephine Bakhita (African, many years a slave); Magdalena of Nagasaki (Japanese martyr).

I'd like to point out that one of the main goals was to have a wide array of saints depicted in heaven. We have much of the globe represented, and thus many cultures and ethnicities as well. Three of the saints are younger, though it will be perhaps a bit harder to notice that Kateri and Magdalena were 24 and 22-23 at the time of death (martyrdom for Magdalena). We have priests, religious sisters, and laity. The saints come from different eras of the Church - ancient, renaissance, modern. I'm happy to have a married couple, which is a two-for-one, and it puts the final count at five men and six women. There are so many amazing saints that it is hard to narrow down to such a small list, even if we could double it to twenty (the space also won't permit so many full-sized images).
