

SEAS St Vincent de Paul Conference presents it's Grow It Forward fundraiser. 4" potted Big Boy Tomato, Sweet 100 Cherry Tomato, green bell pepper, or jalapeño pepper plants(\$5), or seed packets of squash, beans, and greens (\$2) are available to purchase or sponsor for a neighbor being assisted through our St Elizabeth Food Pantry to grow their own this weekend of May 17th & May 18th after all Masses. 
