FR. TERRY'S COLUMN

A BIG THANK YOU

I forgot to say thank you to the leaders of Vacation Bible School. My gratitude goes out to Kelsey Sensibaugh and the many other women who helped her lead us through a beautiful week for our parish community. Wow what a great time that was, and I am sure seeds of faith and of community are planted deep in the hearts of our youngest parishioners. Things like this are so important for the future of the Church - thank you!

This week a lot is happening. While I often think that summer is slower, it often doesn't feel that way! Fidelis will be away for a 5-day, 4-night summer camp. Some of us clergy will accompany them, for part or all of it. That is why we won't have Masses some of the days this week. Meanwhile, Fr. Fortin is leading a retreat with the Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS) - he himself was a missionary with them for a time before entering the religious life. Fr. Jake will be going to assist Fr. Mark Hellinger (who grew up at St. E's) on a pilgrimage in Greece - so don't have too much

pity on us priests for our vocation! I will then hold down the fort with Deacon Sam this weekend and next until their return. Please keep all of our journeys in your prayers.

As we collectively make our pledges this Sunday toward phase II of our renovations, I am filled with gratitude for what our parish does. In the readings this week at daily Masses, Saint Paul emphasized the generosity of God and invited his "flock" in Corinth to be generous like some of the other cities he had ministered to. Along with St. Paul, I am so happy for the generosity I have witnessed among us. So many people have shown that their faith in God is not a secondary part of their lives, but is at the center. Of course, I see this week after week in so many ways: Knights of Columbus, Saint Vincent de Paul Society, Franciscan Center, Christ Child Society, Fraternus, Fidelis, Vacation Bible School, Youth Formation catechists, Adoration, etc. etc. So although I am not surprised by the generosity, I am indeed grateful and proud.

I am not a fan of the construction process and the toll it takes: time, sacrifice, inconvenience, etc. As we look forward to this project that will hopefully start in the fall, I try to remind myself that our first phase was not so different: growing pains and then reaping rewards of that time of trial. So I try to look forward to what is to come. I invite you to do the same, as you imagine a fuller church, new kneelers, organ music, a more inviting and beautiful front entrance, and a more open gathering space with a beautiful font. Your contributions over the next three years will begin to take shape quickly as we start the project using some savings by the finance council's approval. Although we will not have the gathering space for some time, it could bear some positive results in unforeseen ways, especially a greater gratitude for our parish hall and other things we are blessed with. Life is always an adventure, and so we embrace the story God continues to write with our lives. Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton, pray for us!
