Dear Father,

As you know, Bishop Rhoades will be celebrating Jubilee Masses across the diocese. At each of these Masses, Bishop will be offering the Pontifical Blessing which has a plenary indulgence attached according to the normal conditions.

Wednesday, August 13, 2025, 6:30 p.m. at Saint Anthony of Padua Church, Angola (Vicariate D)

Saturday, August 16, 2025, 6:30 p.m. Spanish Mass at Our Lady of Guadalupe Church, Warsaw (Vicariate C)

Thursday, August 21, 2025, 6:30 p.m. at Saint Pius X, Granger (Vicariate A)

Wednesday, September 3, 2025, 6:30 p.m. at Saint Michael Church, Plymouth (Vicariate B)

Wednesday, October 8, 2025, 6:30 p.m. at Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton, Fort Wayne (Vicariate E)

Wednesday, October 29, 6:30 p.m. at Saints Peter and Paul Church, Huntington (Vicariate F)

Bishop would be grateful if all the priests of the Vicariate would plan on concelebrating the Mass for their vicariate, with a few caveats. First, since the only Mass in Vicariate C is a Spanish-language Mass, for those parishioners in Vicariate C who would rather attend Mass in (mostly) English, a different vicariate Mass could be advertised as an option. Second, some of the parishes in other vicariates with large Hispanic populations are free to advertise the Spanish-language Mass at Our Lady of Guadalupe as well as their own vicariate Mass. Third, we also recognize that it may be difficult for all priests of Vicariate C to attend the Mass at Our Lady of Guadalupe because of the need to stay at their parishes to celebrate their own Saturday Vigil Masses.

Pastors, please advertise your vicariate's Jubilee Mass extensively always mentioning the plenary indulgence which can be gained through the pontifical blessing under the normal conditions. In the next couple weeks, the Diocesan Communications Office will be emailing graphics which can be used in the bulletin, as a reference for pulpit announcements, and for parish social media.

Finally, there are two other Jubilee Masses to which all are invited that bishop will offer in addition to the vicariate Masses. These also should be advertised when timely:

Wednesday, September 24, 2025, 5:15 p.m. at the Basilica of the Sacred Heart, Notre Dame

Sunday December 28, 11:30 am. Closing Mass of the Jubilee Year at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, Fort Wayne







PRO-LIFE BABYSHOWER & SPIRITUAL ADOPTION

Annually, the pro-life committee sponsors a baby shower for the Women's Care Center to celebrate the completion of our Spiritual Adoption. Our baby shower celebration will be held on the weekend of July 26 & 27. We are asking that you consider dropping off a baby item for the WCC and placing in the container provided in the church gathering area. Monetary donations can be made by dropping donations in the collection basket in an envelope marked for the "Pro-life Baby Shower", mailed to the church office, or via online giving choosing the Pro-Life fund. Thank you so much for your generosity towards the babies in our community!

Below are some baby shower gift ideas which can be placed in the big bins located in the Gathering Area: diapers, diaper cream, wipes, bibs, toys, bath tub, bath towels, baby shampoo and lotion, blankets, crib sheets, books, pacifiers, teething toys, burb cloths, bottles, socks, onesies, hats, clothes, jackets, etc.

Spiritual Adoption is a precious opportunity to allow God to use you to save the life of babies which is based on an idea by Archbishop Fulton Sheen in which participants pray for a specific, but unknown unborn child for nine months beginning in September. Since the child is adopted "spiritually", it is not necessary to identify an actual unborn child. This can be done in a parish or school setting with age appropriate materials. At the end of the nine months of prayer, a baby shower is held to gather items for a local pregnancy resource center or other organization that provides support for mothers and babies. Thank you for your donation to our baby shower as this will help many families in need.
