FR. TERRY'S COLUMN

It was a pleasure to have Deacon Sam with us for the summer as he got his first experiences of parish ministry after his ordination. Please keep Dcn. Sam and all of the seminarians of our diocese in your prayers as they make their way back to seminary in the days ahead. They are just finishing a week of retreat-vacation together on Lake Wawasee, something that Fr. Jake and I remember fondly from our seminary days. It is a great opportunity for fraternal fellowship so that we truly know each other well as we enter into priestly ministry, God-willing, in the years that follow. And it gives them the right focus to approach a year of seminary formation (studies, prayer, and other training) with the best possible posture: engaged receptivity and attentiveness to the Holy Spirit's guidance.

This August we will pursue the final permissions from the diocese for our Phase II renovations. It seems we are progressing well with our capital campaign so I expect the diocesan finance council will approve our start of the project and bishop will sign the contract with whichever company they award it with (based on the bids we are soon to receive). The Buildings & Grounds board for the diocese will also have to approve our design to make sure it is sound and efficient, both structurally and financially. I have no doubt that the work of our architects has been more than satisfactory in this as well. These final approvals will mean that, hopefully before September, we will have begun our work. If not, it will be as quickly as possible, to ensure that our gathering

space is usable when Holy Week comes around in the early Spring. Please keep this in your prayers.

Also pray for Fr. Jake and myself as we each take some time away during this month. We are doing a little choreographed routine of "revolving doors" with me being the first to temporarily disappear before trading places. We appreciate your prayers for a safe and restorative time out in the Lord's great gift of the natural world.

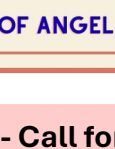
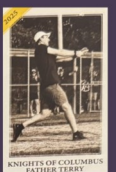
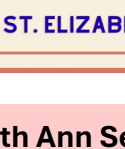
