

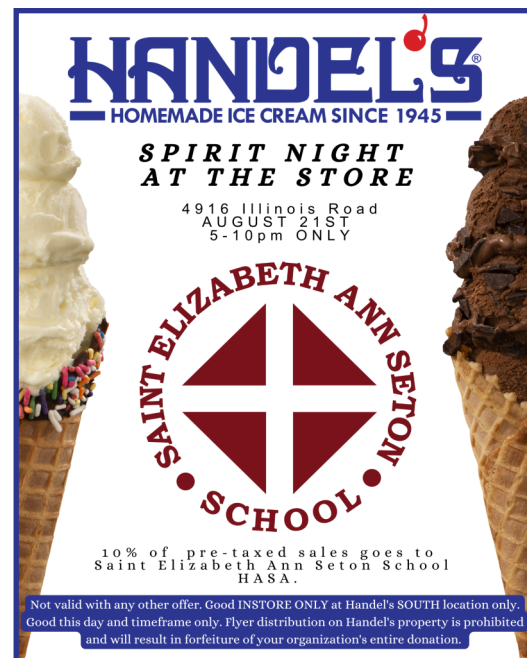
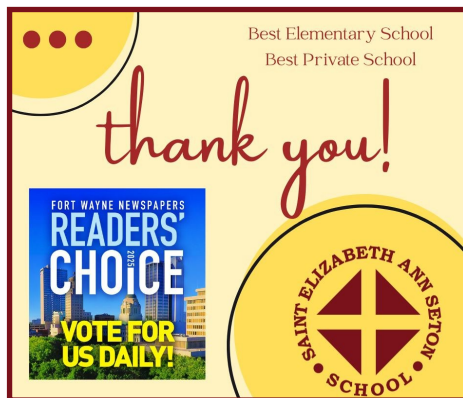
A WORD FROM OUR PRINCIPAL
