FR. TERRY'S COLUMN

PLEASE JOIN US FOR THE JUBILEE MASS

The Jubilee Year that began across the globe last December by Pope Francis is now getting near its close. Our diocese has a couple more celebrations, and one of them is right here in our parish. Bishop Kevin Rhoades will be here on October 8th for a special Mass at 6:30pm. It is is our hope. He gives direction and purpose to the only jubilee Mass in our section of the diocese (known as a "vicariate" and sometimes called a "deanery" in other dioceses of our country), except for the final Mass which will be pessimism, cynicism, and even despair of ever at the Cathedral itself for the last Sunday of the calendar year. We have invited the priests from the rest of the vicariate to attend, and we hope to have a good representation of our part of the diocese to celebrate with Bishop Rhoades this year of hope. "Pilgrims of Hope" is the theme that was established by our late Pope Francis, now enjoying his eternal reward. At the start of the Jubilee Year (typically every 25 years), Bishop Rhoades explained the theme in a homily, which I think is worth hearing again:

The central theme of this Jubilee Year is hope. This year is a wonderful opportunity for us to be renewed in our Christian hope, renewed by the grace of the Lord Jesus who is our hope and salvation. It is in God's grace that we find hope, "the hope that does not disappoint," because, as St. Paul says, "the love of God has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us." The Holy Spirit

enlightens us with the light of hope, the hope we celebrate during this holy season of Christmas, the hope we have because, as the angel announced to the shepherds, "a Savior has been born for us who is Christ and Lord." Jesus our lives. In our earthly lives, we experience uncertainties, disappointments, troubles, and anxieties that can lead to discouragement, finding happiness and peace. That is why we need to be renewed in our hope. And that's why the Holy Father made hope the theme of this Jubilee Year.

The temptation to lose hope is ever present in our world, and the events of the past month emphasize that truth for our world, our nation and our church. We need to be grounded in the true source of our hope if we are to stay strong and overcome the darkness with the light of Christ. If you are able, we encourage you to attend this special event to mark this holy year and to obtain the special indulgence for the spiritual benefit of yourself or one of the faithful departed (relative, friend, or unknown).

Next week, I plan to give a summary review of the Phase II Renovations and capital campaign, so be sure to check the bulletin. I'm glad to be able to share good news of our progress.






