

FR. TERRY'S COLUMN

Catholic Schools Week was beset by almost one foot of snow last weekend. It made for a slow start, but we still were able to celebrate with our school community the great gift of this Catholic school. It is a huge apostolate: we are forming hundreds of students for 180 school days every year, not to mention all the events outside of the school days. It is a huge undertaking, and I thank our teachers, principal (and assistants), and all the staff of the school for their daily sacrifice for this great work. You are a gift, and our students are worth all the effort. God bless our school!

As we are a few weeks away, I would encourage you to begin thinking about Lent. Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving are the three traditional practices we undertake. It can be manifest in many ways. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you see which ways He wants for you to live them, then start formulating your plan.

A Small Faith Group is probably the best way to live your Lent – because then you are living it in community with others. We call them small faith groups because they are just that: small

groups, with our Catholic faith at the center, being the glue that binds us together. Small groups are essential to parishes our size, because we cannot be close friends with thousands of people. Yet we need to have deep relationships with a smaller number, so that we can be more tightly connected with the entire parish family. This is the best way to make a large parish feel like the family it is meant to be. And when we are close to some, even the others feel closer. This is the “holy communion” that God desires for the Body of Christ, which Saint Paul describes with the Greek word ‘koinonia.’ Please consider how you can commit to a small faith group this Lent and hopefully for the rest of your life. Maybe God is calling you to be the organizer of a new group of friends? Do not put it past Him: “nothing is impossible with God.” (Luke ch. 1)

Please mark your calendars for our 40 Hours Devotions this year, March (15th-17th). As usual, we will have three evenings in a row for prayer, teaching, along with Adoration throughout the days and nights between them.


