

FR. TERRY'S COLUMN

Next weekend we have first of two retreat days for our Confirmation students. Over two Saturdays, all of those preparing for the sacrament will have made a retreat in prayerful preparation for this beautiful sacrament.

Also, our participants in the OCIA program will have a weekend of great importance for them: the rite of sending, and rite of election. The first ceremony on Saturday evening happens at the parish where we send them with our prayers to the diocesan event with our bishop. On Sunday afternoon at St. Charles Borromeo Parish, Bishop Rhoades will call many of our participants to the sacrament of Baptism, as well as Confirmation and First Communion, to complete their initiation into our faith. He will also address those who are already baptized and are now converting to the faith, inviting them to the continual conversion that we as Christians are to live throughout our lives, as they prepare also to make their profession, and receive confirmation and first holy communion.

We have quite a bumper crop for OCIA this year, and it is very exciting. It might be a little snug in church on Saturday evening Mass, but I'm happy about that! In fact, Bishop has moved from the Cathedral to St. Charles Borromeo for the Sunday ceremony, simply because we could not all fit in the Cathedral anymore – what a great problem to have!

These members of our community need our prayers as they continue their preparation. Let us continue to intercede for our young Catholics who will receive Confirmation, as well as all of those who are becoming Catholic!

Ash Wednesday is just around the corner. We have many Masses available that day for us to begin our time of penance together as a unified church across the globe. Remember, it is also a day of both fasting and abstinence from meat. The norm for no meat applies to ages 14 and older. (This continues for every Friday of Lent as well.)

The norm for fasting is for all Catholics between ages 18 and 59 who are able to have less food: one normal meal, and two other small meals more like snacks if needed. The grumbling in your stomach can be offered up for your own intentions, including personal sanctification, as well as for the universal Church and for our parish family, especially those mentioned above. May God bless you with a fruitful Lent!






