

FR. TERRY'S COLUMN

The sacred Lenten fast begins this Wednesday. Six and a half weeks from then we will celebrate Our Lord's Resurrection. The holiest celebration of our liturgical calendar demands the longest and most intense preparation for it. It is easiest to do challenging things alongside others, so we begin the journey together: eating less, abstaining from meat, and wearing ashes on our forehead to mark ourselves for God. Although the ashen cross washes off our skin easily enough, we pray that God can keep it deeply imprinted on our souls, marking us as definitively belonging solely the Lord as does our baptism.

As the Hebrews left together in haste under the leadership of Moses from the oppression of Egypt, so we fly from sin and death hidden in the decadence and glitter of a false life of "independence" and "choice" and "personal preference." The desert of Lent is not easy, but it is freeing. It hurts as we learn to grow into what true freedom is, but it is worth it. May we resist the temptation to run back to the familiar comforts of slavery to the usurper of our souls, who cares less for us than pharaoh did for his slaves.

While we say "no" this Lent, we cannot really get somewhere until we turn our focus to the beautiful object of our "yes."

In the work of renewal, it is absolutely essential to have a clear vision of the goal you are pursuing. I leave you with a profound picture of what your "yes" means.

At my conference this past week with the Seminary Formation Council (to help me in mentoring newly ordained men of our diocese), I was reminded of a beautiful description of the lay vocation from the Second Vatican Council. *Lumen Gentium*, one of the flagship documents of the council, says in section 34:

The supreme and eternal Priest, Christ Jesus, since he wills to continue his witness and service also through the laity, vivifies them in this Spirit and increasingly urges them on to every good and perfect work.

For besides intimately linking them to His life and His mission, He also gives them a sharing in His priestly function of offering spiritual worship for the glory of God and the salvation of men. For this reason the laity, dedicated to Christ and anointed by the Holy Spirit, are marvelously called and wonderfully prepared so that ever more abundant fruits of the Spirit may be produced in them. For all their works, prayers and apostolic endeavors, their ordinary married and family life, their daily occupations, their physical and mental relaxation, if carried out in the Spirit, and even the hardships of life, if patiently borne—all these become "spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ". Together with the offering of the Lord's body, they are most fittingly offered in the celebration of the Eucharist. Thus, as those everywhere who adore in holy activity, the laity consecrate the world itself to God.

It is my prayer that during this Lent, we all may continue to deepen our "yes" to this beautiful vocation of consecrating the world to God by our daily offerings of life's circumstances.
