

## Pastors letter

Dear parishioners,

Normally December 8<sup>th</sup> is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of our Blessed Mother. However, since December 8<sup>th</sup> falls on the Second Sunday of Advent, the Advent Sunday Mass takes precedence and the Immaculate Conception Feast is transferred to Monday, the 9<sup>th</sup> of December.

Our Lady, under the title of the Immaculate Conception, is the patroness of the United States of America. Because the feast is transferred to Monday, the obligation to attend Mass is dispensed. Nonetheless, we will have one Mass on Monday for this Feast at 9 AM and in our main Church rather than the chapel.

Some Catholics and most Protestants believe that the Immaculate Conception pertains to the manner in which Our Lord was conceived in the womb of the Blessed Virgin Mary. That would be wrong because the Immaculate Conception refers to the manner in which our Blessed Mother was conceived in the womb of her Mother, Saint Anne, our patron saint. The Annunciation is what defines the manner in which Jesus was conceived in the womb of our Blessed Mother.

For our Blessed Mother's conception, there is no biological miracle. Through the marital act of Saints Anne and Joachim, our Blessed Mother was conceived. However, from the earliest period of the Church, Christians believe that at the moment of her conception, Immaculate Mary was conceived without the stain of original sin.

This means that from all eternity, God chose our Blessed Mother to be the Mother of Jesus, the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity, God incarnate. As the Archangel Gabriel makes clear at the Annunciation to our Blessed Mother, he declares "Hail Mary, full of Grace". This declaration is the Scriptural foundation for the Immaculate Conception.

Furthermore, the Church believes that not only was our Blessed Mother conceived without original sin, she never committed any actual sins in her life, venial or mortal. The abundance of being "full of Grace" enabled her to use her free will to be obedient to God in all things but without compromising her free will. In other words, she wasn't "used" by God for His divine purposes, but rather, our Blessed Mother cooperated fully with God in His plan for her and for us.

God's plan is to undo the damage that Adam and Eve inflicted upon us by their Original Sin, which loss for them and us sanctifying grace necessary for living forever in the presence of God in heaven or the Garden of Eden. Our Blessed Mother is God's antidote to the disobedience of Adam and Eve. They, too, were conceived without sin but committed sin nonetheless through the silly temptation of a talking snake who convinced them they could become gods, if only they would eat the fruit that God had forbidden them to eat. Original Sin is really the deadly sin of pride, thinking we can be a god.

Our Blessed Mother won't be fooled by a talking snake or tempted by the real temptations of the fallen world in which she was born, a world that God wants to save through her and her Son Jesus Christ.

Heaven, though, is not automatic. We must be baptized to have sanctifying grace restored. We must have faith in God, live a sacramental life in the Church and perform good works that merit us actual graces. We must die in a state of grace free of all unrepented mortal sins. The Church Jesus founded, is like our Blessed Mother who leads us to Mary and our Lord and the means by which we are saved from damnation.

If the flu becomes epidemic, the common chalice and “handshake of peace” will be suspended. Keep in mind that Catholic teaching insists that we receive the Body and Blood of Jesus entirely under either form of the Host or Precious Blood.
