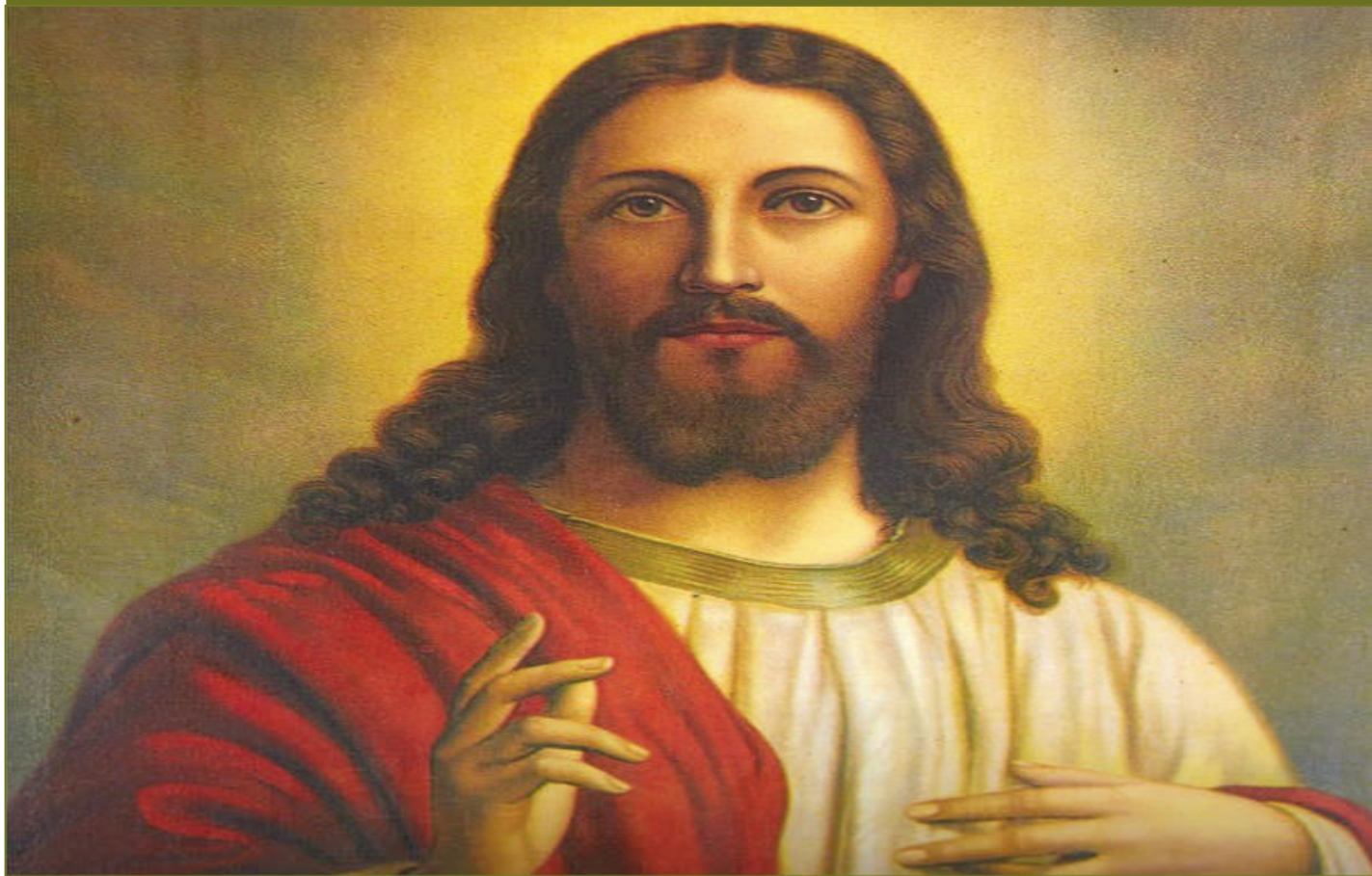

GOSPEL MEDITATION

August 24, 2025

21st Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 13:22-30

I've been hiking Camelback Mountain in Phoenix, Arizona most of my life. It is a vigorous forty-five minutes to the top. Near the peak, the end suddenly appears much further away, and steeper. At that moment, a descending hiker often offers encouragement: "Keep going! The peak is right there. It's not as far as it looks. You can do it!" It usually works. After another five minute push, you summit and enjoy a glorious panorama of the Sonoran Desert in the Valley of the Sun. When Jesus is asked about how many people are saved, he says: "**Strive to enter through the narrow gate**" (Luke 13:24). How many? Strive! Focus on your journey. What does heavenly census taking have to do with you or me? How would it help a hiker on a mountain to ask the others coming down, "How many people are going to make it to the top?" A normal response would be something like: "How is that a relevant question? Carry on!"

Jesus links one virtue directly to salvation: perseverance (cf. Matt 24:13; *hypomone* in Greek). Strive! Endure!

Keep going! The one absolutely necessary

virtue is perseverance, to not give up on our journey.

The mountain we struggle to climb is often our own weakness, failures, and sins. Persevere in prayer. Keep celebrating the sacraments. Embrace daily duties. With God's grace, you are strong enough to keep going. Perhaps the peak is not as far away as you might fear. Keep going!

REGISTRATION

Are you new to the area or new to the Catholic community of Most Holy Name of Jesus Parish? If yes, the registration is simple. BAPTISM

Baptisms are celebrated at 2:00pm first and third Saturday of the month at Our Lady of Hungary Church

Anyone interested in baptizing his/her child, please visit our parish office to complete the corresponding form.

Sponsor letters must be provided before the date is approved.

REQUIREMENTS TO BE GODPARENTS

- Must be at least 18 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism, and Eucharist
- Must be an active registered parishioner for at least six months in a Catholic church, attending and receiving Holy Communion at weekly Mass, contributing to the church's support
- Those who are not registered with our parish must bring a permission letter to be a sponsor from their parish.

We can only write eligibility letters for parishioners who meet this criteria. These requirements are the **universal law** of the Church, and are not determined by any individual in the parish.

MARRIAGE

Ideally, registered parishioners of the Holy Name of Jesus Parish can make arrangements at least one year in advance. Please stop by the Parish Office to fill out the corresponding form, so that immediately afterwards one of our Priests schedules an appointment to speak with you to secure a date. The date with the church must be confirmed before making other social plans.

REQUISITOS PARA SER PADRINOS

- Debe tener al menos 18 años de edad, haber recibido el Sacramento del Bautismo, y la Eucaristía
- Debe ser un feligrés registrado activo durante al menos seis meses en una iglesia católica, asistir y recibir la Sagrada Comunión en la misa semanal, contribuyendo al apoyo de la iglesia
- Aquellos que no están registrados en nuestra parroquia deben traer una carta de permiso de su parroquia para ser padrino.

Solo podemos escribir cartas de elegibilidad para los feligreses que cumplen con este criterio. Estos requisitos son la ley universal de la Iglesia y no están determinados por ningún individuo en la parroquia.

MATRIMONIO

Idealmente, los feligreses registrados de la Parroquia del Santo Nombre de Jesús pueden hacer arreglos por lo menos con un año de anticipación. MEDITACION DEL EVANGELIO

24 de agosto de 2025

XXI Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

¿Has intentado alguna vez o has tenido la experiencia de entrar por alguna puerta angosta? Es incómodo y te sientes apretado si intentan entrar más de dos personas al mismo tiempo. Nos gustan las puertas anchas, altas y bonitas. La puerta angosta es para entrar de uno en uno, no más.

"Esfuércense por entrar por la puerta angosta, porque yo les digo que muchos tratarán de entrar y no lo lograrán" (Lucas 13:24). La manera de hablar de Jesús es diferente a otras ocasiones. Habla claro y directo: dice "esfuércense". Nada es fácil; moldear la arcilla de lo que estamos hechos requiere de esfuerzo.

El Evangelio de hoy también nos advierte: *"Unos que estaban entre los últimos son ahora los primeros, mientras que los primeros han pasado a ser los últimos" (Lucas 13:30).* ¡Qué sorpresa tan grande! Dios no nos reconocerá por nuestros títulos ni por los puestos de importancia en la sociedad, mucho menos por la riqueza y las propiedades. Así que, ahora sí, se comprende el mensaje de esforzarse para entrar por la puerta angosta. *"Ahora considero un deber mío explicarles por qué la puerta es angosta. Cualesquiera que desee entrar, primero, y antes que nada, tiene que poseer una fe honrada e incontaminada; en segundo lugar, una vida sin mancha, sin pecado, en la que no existan posibilidades de culpa, conforme a la medida de la justicia humana" (San Cirilo de Alejandría, 375-444, Comentario al Evangelio de San Lucas).*

Words From The Pastor/Palabras del Párroco

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,
In today's Gospel, someone asks Jesus a difficult question: "Lord, will only a few be saved?" Instead of giving a number or a statistic, Jesus turns the question around and says: "Strive to enter through the narrow door."

What does this mean?

The "narrow door" is not about how small Heaven is, but about the challenge of living faithfully.

It reminds us that salvation is not automatic; it is a gift of God, but one that calls for our response, our effort, and our daily conversion.

Jesus warns that it is not enough to say: "We ate and drank with you" or "We knew you."

Simply

being near Jesus or having a superficial relationship with Him is not enough. What matters is living as His disciple — following His teaching, showing love, practicing mercy, and walking in humility.

This Gospel has three lessons for us:

1. Faith is more than words or rituals.

Being Christian is not just about church attendance or outward signs. It is about allowing Christ to shape our lives, our choices, and our hearts.

2. The narrow door means effort and discipline.

Just as an athlete trains to compete, we too must discipline our hearts through prayer, self-denial, forgiveness, and works of love. The narrow door does not mean God wants to exclude us, but that discipleship requires commitment.

3. The last will be first, and the first will be last.

Jesus reminds us that God's ways are not our ways. Many who appear powerful or important may find themselves last, while the humble and faithful — those who lived with love and trust in God — will be welcomed first.

Brothers and sisters, today Jesus invites us not to be curious about "how many" will be saved, but to ask instead: "Am I walking toward the narrow door each day?" The door is open, but it requires us to let go of pride, selfishness, and sin, and to enter with humility, faith, and love. Let us pray for the grace to strive each day to follow Christ more closely, so that when the door is finally closed, we may be found among those whom the Master welcomes into His eternal banquet.

'MOST HOLY NAME OF JESUS PARISH'

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

En el Evangelio de hoy, alguien le hace a Jesús una pregunta difícil: "Señor, ¿se salvarán pocos?"

En lugar de dar una cifra o una estadística, Jesús le da la vuelta a la pregunta y dice: "Esfuércense por entrar por la puerta estrecha".

¿Qué significa esto?

La "puerta estrecha" no se refiere a lo pequeño que es el Cielo, sino al desafío de vivir con fidelidad.

Nos recuerda que la salvación no es automática; es un don de Dios, pero que exige nuestra respuesta, nuestro esfuerzo y nuestra conversión diaria.

Jesús advierte que no basta con decir: "Comimos y bebimos contigo" o "Te conocimos". Simplemente estar cerca de Jesús o tener una relación superficial con él no basta. Lo que importa es vivir como sus discípulos: seguir sus enseñanzas, mostrar amor, practicar la misericordia y vivir con humildad.

Este Evangelio nos ofrece tres lecciones:

1. La fe es más que palabras o rituales.

Ser cristiano no se trata solo de asistir a la iglesia ni de señales externas. Se trata de permitir que Cristo moldee nuestras vidas, nuestras decisiones y nuestros corazones.

2. La puerta estrecha implica esfuerzo y disciplina.

Así como un atleta se entrena para competir, nosotros también debemos disciplinar nuestros corazones mediante la oración, la abnegación, el perdón y las obras de amor. La puerta estrecha no significa que Dios quiera excluirnos, sino que el discipulado requiere compromiso.

3. Los últimos serán los primeros, y los primeros, los últimos.

Jesús nos recuerda que los caminos de Dios no son los nuestros. Muchos que parecen poderosos o importantes pueden encontrarse últimos, mientras que los humildes y fieles —aquellos que vivieron con amor y confianza en Dios— serán recibidos primero.

Hermanos y hermanas, hoy Jesús nos invita a no sentir curiosidad por «cuántos» se salvarán, sino a preguntarnos: «¿Camino hacia la puerta estrecha cada día?». La puerta está abierta, pero requiere que dejemos de lado el orgullo, el egoísmo y el pecado, y entremos con humildad, fe y amor. Oremos por la gracia de esforzarnos cada día por seguir a Cristo más de cerca, para que cuando la puerta finalmente se cierre, podamos estar entre aquellos a quienes el Maestro acoge en su banquete eterno. 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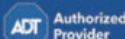
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
