Second Sunday in Ordinary Time—January 18, 2026

Stewardship Reflection on Lectionary Readings

IS 49:3, 5-6; PS 40:2, 4, 7-10; 1 COR 1:1-3; JN 1:29-34

Today's readings provide clear and inspiring reminders of the most fundamental aspect of our identity — that of servants of our most high and holy God, His modern-day disciples, and stewards.

John the Baptist recognized the holiness of Jesus and the response due to Him when he encountered Christ in person on the day they met at the Jordan River. His response, which we read in our Gospel passage from St. John was, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world... He is the one of whom I said, 'A man is coming after me who ranks ahead of me because he existed before me.'"

What a powerful description of our Lord and the place He should rightfully have in each of our lives. He is truly our Savior, the only one who can free us from our sinfulness. We are utterly and completely dependent on His power, love, and mercy. Therefore, He truly does "rank ahead" of us; he deserves to be first, above all other priorities and plans in our lives. Let us examine our daily lives and encourage our children to do the same.

Does the way I spend my time reflect that God comes first? Do prayer and weekly Mass, regular confession, and time with my family "rank ahead" of everything else on my calendar? Do I use my talents, skills, and energy to serve my family, parish and community in thanksgiving and recognition that God's kingdom ranks ahead of any other goals or ambitions? Do I spend my money and use my material possessions to glorify God?

Challenge questions, to be sure. But questions worthy of our high calling as Christian stewards offered a glorious mission in service of our Lord and His kingdom. What will our response be?

Parish Statistics do not provide the kind of accurate information desired but they do indicate general trends. In the past two years it appears that we maintained a relatively stable parish population and Sunday collection income.

Registered families are not necessarily attending families, nor are they necessarily using their envelopes or online giving to contribute financially. We cannot possibly know how many families/persons donate with cash.

The blue box to the left makes use of actual data that we do have. Although the data is limited, the extrapolated results seems much more reasonable. Note that the result is "per individual", not per adult.

I take this opportunity to emphasize the significance of your parish participation. The principal means of support for the Catholic Church of St. Ann is your weekly generosity. What is normally donated online and what gets placed in the collection basket makes up the "ordinary income" for parish operation. Expense for parish operation means the salaries and benefits for the employees who serve you; all costs for utilities and supplies; ministries and formation programs; resources needed for quality liturgies; snowplowing and landscaping, maintenance and custodial services to all of our buildings and properties—church, convent, rectory/office and school building. Nothing can happen here without the support of parishioners, and we are very grateful for whatever sacrifices you make.

If you are not presently using your envelopes, please do so as a reminder to yourself to be grateful for what God has given to you and so that you intentionally and consistently participate in supporting the parish and our mission. Many envelopes that we send out are not being used, at a cost to the parish.

If you are not on a fixed income, consider doing an evaluation of your charitable giving. What percentage of your ordinary income do you give to your church and other worthy charitable organizations? What do you normally give to support your parish? How long have you been giving that same amount? Like in your own household, our parish expenses will typically increase each. When was the last time you adjusted your sacrificial giving? We ask you to prayerfully consider at least a cost of living increase for the Parish each year.
