## Sunday April 21, 2024 ~ Fourth Sunday of Easter

### From the Bishop's Pen...

"The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep."

This is Good Shepherd Sunday. A Good Shepherd does not work for wages alone. A Good Shepherd truly "loves his flock," and willingly gives himself completely to care for them. His sheep know his voice and follow him. They know he keeps them safe.

If a landowner has a flock of sheep, a son and hired workers, who would you think would be the Good Shepherd for the sheep? Who would be the one who would give himself completely to caring for the sheep, because the landowner asked him? The landowner's son, of course, would be best suited to obey his father and completely care for his sheep.

God the Father has multiple flocks of sheep scattered throughout the world, but He wants them to become one flock, cared for by the Good Shepherd. Jesus is the Good Shepherd, because He willingly lays down His life for His sheep to do His Father's will. Jesus loves his sheep so much that He would not abandon them, even at the cost of His own life.

We too are His sheep, but we are now more than just sheep that Jesus shepherds. Through baptism, we are members of His Body. We have become adopted children of God the Father. Therefore, like the Son, we are called by the Father to be shepherds to one another. That is why Jesus calls us to go out and gather sheep from the other flocks into His one flock, as members of His Body.

Now, we can understand what Peter said in today's First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles, "Leaders of the people and elders: If we are being examined today about a good deed done to a cripple, namely, by what means he was saved, then all of you and all the people of Israel should know that it was in the name of Jesus Christ the Nazorean whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead; in his name this man stands before you healed."

Jesus, the Good Shepherd, who gave His life for His sheep, has called us as members of His Body; to be good shepherds to everyone we meet, healing them through the love God has given us in His Son, and calls us to give to each other.

#### **GOSPEL MEDITATION**

ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE
April 21, 2024 4th Sunday of Easter

Recently I was with my little dog Libby at a retreat center in the Arizona desert. I sat in a chair near a ravine filled with shrubs. Unbeknownst to me, Libby wandered down there and disappeared. Suddenly an animal's wild shriek erupted from the area. Without thinking, I bolted down into the ravine fully expecting to see coyotes, javelinas, or rattlesnakes. I didn't care. I desperately wanted to get Libby out of there, without any self-regard. Before I could face whatever danger lay hidden, my dog blissfully trotted out from an entirely different area, utterly unaware that I had (quite heroically) just placed my life on the line.

When the adrenaline wore off, I thought to myself: how far would I have been willing to go to save her? I don't know. But I do know, if I had literally died, my friends and family would have certainly thought me insane for dying for a dog. No offense, Libby.

How passionately Jesus wants us to know him and his willingness to die for us! This week he says, "I know my own and my own know me," and "I lay down my life for the sheep." Here we encounter an insanely excessive love for us. Christianity is a relationship and not simply a religion or ethical code. In Jesus, God rescues and saves us. He laid down his life for you and me — and he has taken it up again. So often we are like Libby — blissfully ignorant of the reality of both our spiritual danger and his saving love. This Easter season, the risen Jesus calls us to be more conscious than ever before about his love. He never ceases to lay down his life for us.




