

A message from our Pastor...

The Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph

My dear friends:

In his first encyclical, "Lumen Fidei," or "The Light of Faith," July 5, 2013, Pope Francis highlighted the need to let Christ's love transform and renew our lives, so that we may transmit our faith to the world. "Faith is born of an encounter with the living God who calls us and reveals his love for building our lives."

"Transformed by this love, we gain fresh vision, new eyes to see; we realize that it contains a great promise of fulfillment, and that a vision of the future opens up before us." He noted the key role of family as a critical setting for the growth of faith, specifically referencing "the stable union of man and woman in marriage," which creates the good of new life.

The Holy Family consisted of:

- 1. The mother, who consented to conceive a child through the power of the Holy Spirit
- 2. The father, who listened to angels and fled to another country, turning his family for a time into refugees
- 3. The son, who gave everything on the cross

That which made them so remarkable is that they were so unremarkable. They were not rich or influential. They were just Jesus, Mary and Joseph: the carpenter's family, from a place called Nazareth who did all they did out of love.

Nazareth was a place of everyday life and everyday problems, in fact in Sacred Scripture someone even mocks it by saying: "Can anything good come out of Nazareth?"

In Paul's beautiful letter to the Colossians, our second reading this weekend, he speaks eloquently of love. Paul was not writing about romantic love. The letter we hear today is about how to form a healthy and holy Christian community. How do we do this? "Put on compassion," Paul tells us kindness, lowliness, meekness, patience, forgiveness, and love."

We could do nothing better than to follow that model: to live faithfully, each in our own world, remembering the example of the Holy Family. Remembering to open our eyes and our hearts to what is around us. Cherish every ordinary, mundane, stressful, joyful moment at home. And if you do, your family may discover something the Holy Family knew so well: that the living God reveals His love for building our lives, "and transformed by this love, we realize that it contains the grace for a promise of fulfillment, a vision of hope and everlasting love, now and in the future."

MEMORANDUM

Subject: Vaccines for COVID-19 **Date:** 23 November 2020



There appears to be some confusion in the media regarding the moral permissibility of using the vaccines for COVID-19 developed by Pfizer Inc. and Moderna. We would like to offer some clarifications.

Neither the Pfizer nor the Moderna vaccine involved the use of cell lines that originated in fetal tissue taken from the body of an aborted baby at any level of design, development, or production. They are not completely free from any connection to abortion, however, as both Pfizer and Moderna made use of a tainted cell line for one of the confirmatory lab tests of their products. There is thus a connection, but it is relatively remote. Some are asserting that if a vaccine is connected in any way with tainted cell lines then it is immoral to be vaccinated with them. This is an inaccurate portrayal of Catholic moral teaching.

There are three documents from the Holy See that treat the question of tainted vaccines: 1) the 2005 study by the Pontifical Academy for Life, "Moral Reflections on Vaccines Prepared from Cells Derived from Aborted Human Foetuses"; 2) paragraphs nos. 34-35 in the 2008 Instruction on Certain Bioethical Questions (Dignitatis Personae) by the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith; 3) the 2017 Note on Italian Vaccine Issue, by the Pontifical Academy for Life. These documents all point to the immorality of using tissue taken from an aborted child for creating cell lines. They also make distinctions in terms of the moral responsibility of the various actors involved, from those involved in designing and producing a vaccine to those receiving the vaccine. Most importantly, they all make it clear that, at the level of the recipient, it is morally permissible to accept vaccination when there are no alternatives and there is a serious risk to health.

The Pontifical Academy for Life gives as an example the case of rubella (German measles): "We find, in such a case, a proportional reason, in order to accept the use of these vaccines in the presence of the danger of favouring the spread of the pathological agent, due to the lack of vaccination of children. This is particularly true in the case of vaccination against German measles."²

The Pontifical Academy does call for appropriate expressions of protest against the origins of these vaccines as well as for vigorous efforts to promote the creation of alternatives. "There remains a moral duty to continue to fight and to employ every lawful means in order to make life difficult for the pharmaceutical industries which act unscrupulously and unethically." The Pontifical Academy adds, however, that public health must not be sacrificed. "The burden of this important battle cannot and must not fall on innocent children and on the health situation of the population."
