



#### PreKindergarten - 3



The students in the 3-year-old class have been enjoying the new friendships they have

formed. Since the New Year began, it has been a lot of fun as the children continue to grow and learn.

In language arts, Mrs. Karen Losada's and Mrs. Gina D'Amato's students continue to focus on a different letter and its sound each week. Every day is a different activity relating to the letter of the week, such as "show and share", writing practice, free play, and various crafts. The class is more than halfway through the alphabet already! The children have been working hard on spelling and writing their names and, this past month, began having fun with rhyming words.





In math, the students have been practicing their numbers through 12, making patterns, and cutting different shapes. They do all this while working on their fine motor skills. The children are also exploring one to one correspondence and rote counting.

In January and February, the students focused on various social studies and science facts. They

celebrated Valentine's Day, Presidents Day, and the 100th day of school. In January they discussed the four seasons and learned all about Winter, and animals in the Arctic and Antarctic. The children explored their 5 senses with experiments and fun hands on activities and spent most of the month of February discussing health, fitness, and exercise learning about the five food groups and how important it is to eat healthy. After discussing "Community Leaders" the students enjoyed a visit from two local EMT's who shared their special jobs and gave a tour of the ambulance!

Religion is a big part of the week at Saint James Preschool. The Lenten season has begun, and the students have been discussing how Lent is a time to prepare our hearts and minds for Easter. They discussed the "3 pillars" of Lent - prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Mrs. Losada and Mrs. D'Amato have helped the students explore ideas on how to practice these pillars, not just during Lent, but all the time.

The students and their teachers look forward to all that the Spring has to offer and growing in their faith each day. Saint James Pre-Kindergarten is a place where all children learn, play, and make new friends all year round. It is so much fun!
