A message from our Pastor...

The Most Holy Trinity

God is Merciful, Gracious, Rich in Kindness, Faithful, Forgiving, Three in One, and, Love.

My dear friends:

Can anyone explain the Triune God we worship and adore? The answer is no, but I will try by utilizing the Sacred Scriptures as my guide.

On this, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, the Church offers us an opportunity to reflect more deeply on our Triune God. In our first reading from the Book of Exodus 34:6 we read, "The LORD, the LORD, a **merciful** and **gracious** God, slow to anger and **rich in kindness** and **faithful**." Moses asks God to pardon the stiff-necked people and **forgive** their wickedness and sins. The point that Moses wants to make here is that God is clearly committed to caring for them in every way. Then the most fitting display of gratitude the people can show is a firm resolve to "praise and exalt Him above all forever" [Daniel 3:57] and remain faithful to the covenant.

In the second reading, Paul in his second letter to the Corinthians 2:13-13, refers to the Father, the Son and the Spirit, as he writes, "the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you." This greeting is used at the beginning of Mass reminding us that **we are one with God**. Our union with Christ takes us up into the family of the Holy Trinity.

The emphasis in the Gospel of John 3:16-18, is on the second person of the Most Holy Trinity, Jesus, God's only Son who was sent into the world, not to condemn it, but that the world might be saved through Him. The doctrine of **three persons in one God**, equal in divinity, yet distinct in personality, is not explicitly spelled out in the Bible. We do, however, find in the Sacred Scriptures many references to the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Jesus teaches us the close union with the Father and the Spirit as a bond of **Love**. The Holy Trinity is a model of life to be imitated. There is a very simple way to reflect on the mystery we celebrate this Sunday. The life of the Holy Trinity is a life of intense sharing of the same life, in the most perfect manner possible.

What message, then do we take home this Sunday?

1. God is three persons in one God, equal in divinity, yet distinct in personality.
2. God is merciful.
3. God is rich in kindness.
4. God is faithful.
5. God is forgiving.
6. God is Love.

Since the Holy Trinity is a model of life to be imitated, each time we make the sign of the cross and say, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit," remember to imitate the love of the Trinity by a firm resolve to be merciful, kind, faithful to His covenant, forgiving, and filled with love.



St. James School News

5th Grade

As we near the end of the school year, Miss Alex Donaldson's and Mrs. Loren MacTaggart's 5th graders are still working diligently on projects and assignments. They are preparing themselves to become middle school students.

Mrs. MacTaggart worked with students creating their own rosary beads. The students used polymer clay, which was then baked and glazed. Then they strung the beads adding spacers, a medallion, and a cross. After the Rosary beads were blessed, the students prayed a decade of the Rosary, daily, in Religion class during the month of May.



In Math, students have been working on translating phrases into algebraic expressions and graphing points on the Coordinate Plane. In addition, the 5th grade students will be analyzing their Math Portfolios this week and grading themselves on the Standards for Mathematical Practice, such as striving for perseverance in problem solving and attending to precision when calculating problems.

In science, Miss Donaldson's students learned more about our solar system and the characteristics of each planet. At the end of the unit, students designed their own planet. The task required students to determine the distance from the sun & earth, the chemical composition of the atmosphere, landforms, & life. Students presented their planets to the class. During writing, students are writing a persuasive essay on why people should visit their planet.



Students have been using different methods of reading for their novel studies. We have rotated between audiobooks, partner reading, popcorn reading, and independent reading. Students are increasing areas of weakness by answering questions while the book is being read by different methods.


