


A message from our Pastor...

Transfiguration of the Lord

My dear friends:

This weekend we are celebrating the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord. This event was so inspiring that we find it in all the synoptic gospels. Tradition holds that Mount Tabor is where the Transfiguration took place.

The Transfiguration is presented as the point where the human person has the opportunity to see God glorified. Mount Tabor is the meeting place for the temporal and the eternal, with Jesus as the bridge between heaven and earth. It supports the identity of Jesus as the Son of God and identifies him as the messenger of God. By the statement "listen to him" God is surpassing the Laws of Moses and the prophecies of Elijah.



In Matthew 17:1-9; Mark 9:2-8 and Luke 9:28-36, we are invited to take a peek at the glorification of the Lord. St. Thomas Aquinas considered the Transfiguration the greatest miracle in that it complemented baptism and showed the perfection of life in Heaven.

The Transfiguration comforted the Apostles, giving them proof of the divinity of Christ and a preparation for the glory of the Resurrection at Easter. "For after he had told the disciples of his coming death, on the holy mountain he manifested to them His glory, to show, even by the testimony of the law {Moses} and the prophets {Elijah}, that the Passion led to the glory of the Resurrection." (Preface, Second Sunday of Lent)

Be comforted by this feast. Although the Lord will suffer the agony of the Cross, we are assured of the Resurrection not just of the Lord, but of our own resurrection to a new and glorified life.

Registration is now open for the National Eucharistic Congress! At the National Eucharistic Congress (<https://www.eucharisticcongress.org/>), the Church will draw into a deeper intimacy with our Eucharistic Lord, allowing our eyes to be opened and our hearts to be set on fire with his love. This historic five-day gathering (July 17-21, 2024) will be an experience of prayer: a liturgical act offering the Catholic Church—those in attendance in Indianapolis as well as across the country—to the Father, through the Son, and in the Holy Spirit. This reconsecration will result in a massive outpouring of grace and renewed missionary sending as participants are moved to share the Eucharistic love of the Lord “for the life of the world” (John 6:51). This is a pivotal moment in both American history and the legacy of the Catholic Church. (It is the first National Eucharistic Congress in 83 years!) Tens of thousands of pilgrims are expected to attend—but space is limited. To ensure that the Diocese of Metuchen is well-represented, we are pleased to announce that we have purchased 100 tickets to next summer’s Congress.
