From the desk of Fr. Ben... 16 February 2020



The readings this weekend speak clearly of the moral law as a precious gift from God! Jesus does not abolish the law, rather He consistently calls us to an even higher expression of the law, whereby we allow the spirit of the law to enter and transform even our hearts!

One very modern prejudice is that God's law is just some made-up silliness designed to keep us from having fun. (By the way, good luck living that!) As if God were a petty tyrant

making us jump through illogical hoops to show us who's really boss! It's as if someone ignoring a sign like the one above could say after having fallen to their injury: "Man, they really threw the book at me for breaking that silly rule!"

No, that's not how it is! Just like the person who puts up the sign because there really is a cliff and it really is dangerous, God tells us what is morally true so that we may avoid the danger and destruction that naturally result from sin. In this sense, sin is its own punishment. Sinful choices have as their natural and intrinsic outcome the spoiling of our lives and relationships. Because God loves us, He warns us!

The words of the Psalm model for us an intelligent attitude based in reality and wisdom: joyful gratitude for a God who loves us so much that He tells us the truth! "Be good to your servant, that I may live and keep your words. Open my eyes, that I may consider the wonders of your law." Dare I say, this is the attitude of a mature adult, as opposed to the wild self-justifying prejudice of the undisciplined child!

We have a new time for our weekly Eucharistic Holy Hour. Not many people were able to come on Thursday evenings. Now the weekly Holy Hour has moved to Tuesday at 4:00 pm, preceding the Tuesday evening Mass. Please take advantage of this time to pray before the Blessed Sacrament!

I've been talking with Sr. Jacqueline for a couple years about trying to provide good access to an RCIA program here at St. Anne's. We will be offering a 7-week process starting in June & July this coming summer, taking place after the 9 am Mass on Sundays. This would be for people preparing for baptism, non-Catholic Christians who want to become Catholic, and Catholic adults who want to prepare for Confirmation. If you're interested, or know someone who's interested, please talk to Sr. Jacqueline or I! We already have 4 or 5 people planning to participate!

Next Sunday (Feb. 23) we will be having our annual Mardi Gras celebration! Feb. 26 is Ash Wednesday, and so we will gather to celebrate and feast before we enter into our communal time of fasting and penance. Please come and join us, bring your family member and friends!

In our Gospel this Sunday, one of the things Jesus reaffirms is the Church's teaching on marriage. This has always been challenging for people to live and understand. I have been blessed during my priesthood to help many couples work to regularize their marriages, to seek the Church's blessing, or to overcome other similar obstacles. I am also always willing to sit down or talk with an individual or couple about these matters. Please let me know if I can assist your or a family member or friend in some way!
