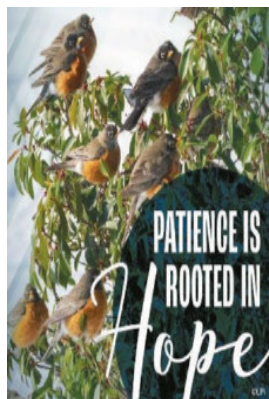


From Fr. Brian's Desk

Rest in Peace



Recently the Archdiocese of Chicago has lost three priests who have made an impact on their respective communities. On June 25th, Fr. Martin Zielinski passed away after a long battle with cancer. Fr. Marty spent 32 years at Mundelein Seminary where he was a teacher, Spiritual Director, and Academic Dean. He also served as Vice President for Ongoing Formation for the Archdiocese of Chicago. Fr. Marty loved being a priest and he loved teaching!

On July 13th, Rev. William Finnegan passed away. Rev. Finnegan assisted at several parishes throughout his life, but he was best known for being the founding pastor of Our Lady of the Woods in Orland Park. He had a great sense of humor and always had a welcoming spirit. Fr. Finnegan was peacefully laid to rest on Friday, July 21st.

Finally, last weekend we heard the sad news of Bishop John Manz passing away. Bishop Manz was a retired auxiliary bishop for the Archdiocese of Chicago. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1971 and to the episcopacy in 1996. Bishop Manz was a very generous, humble, and honest man who practiced his faith in word and action.

We pray: *Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.*

WEEKLY STEWARDSHIP RECOMMENDATION:

Plastic waste is a huge and growing problem. Only 9% of the 9 billion tons of plastic produced has been recycled. There is very little demand for the plastic you do recycle. 40% of all plastic is designed to be used once and tossed. Plastic doesn't decompose easily and can last 100s of years. The waste clogs landfills and waterways, and poses hazards to animals and fish life. It breaks up into ever smaller microplastics getting into our air and food chain with unknown health effects.

What you can do:

- Say NO to single-use plastic. Carry your own cups, bags, to-go containers, utensils and forget the straws.
- Say NO to bottled water and pop. Carry refillables.
- Choose more biodegradable/recyclable materials like glass, paper, cardboard and metal instead of plastic... and then recycle those items.
- Avoid products with excessive packaging, excessive plastic packaging and parts. If it leaves behind plastic trash, try not to buy it.

Recycle what you can't refuse, reduce or reuse.
