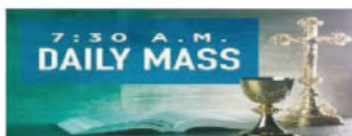
God of power and mercy,

Reminder—Summer Intensive R.E. Program

June 16th - June 20th AND June 23rd - June 27th, 10:00am – 12:00pm
Grades 3 through 6

St. Patrick Ministry Building at 205 Cass St.

Drop-off between 9:40am and 9:55am at the two rear doors, in the driveway between St. Patrick Church and the Ministry Building. Enter the parking lot (against the arrows) off of Cass St. and pull around to the back.

Students may bring a snack and water bottle.

Students must attend all classes. Two chapters are covered each day.

All doors will be locked during classes. If you need to come into the building during class time, please park and come to the front door where there is a bell to ring to be let in.

Pick-up is at the same place as drop-off, at the two rear doors, in the driveway between St. Patrick Church and the Ministry Building. Enter the parking lot (against the arrows) off of Cass St. and pull up into the marked lanes. When classes are released, cars will then be directed one at a time to pull around to the back. Please pull all the way up so that 4-5 cars can be loaded at one time.

All Summer Intensive students who are not going to be enrolled in the Fall program are required to return for two events, one during Advent and one during Lent. These events will include confession and a seasonal lesson. Dates to be announced. Families will be notified by email.

Watch for an email the last week of May to sign up for a Special Blessing Mass for our Summer Intensive Students. The two masses will be June 21st at 4pm at St. Alphonsus Church and June 22nd at 9am at St. Patrick Church and you can pick either one.

We have received all registrations and you should have received an email confirming your child has been registered for the Summer Intensive Program. If you haven't please contact Colleen Kinnunen at re@st-als.org or phone 630-754-7277.

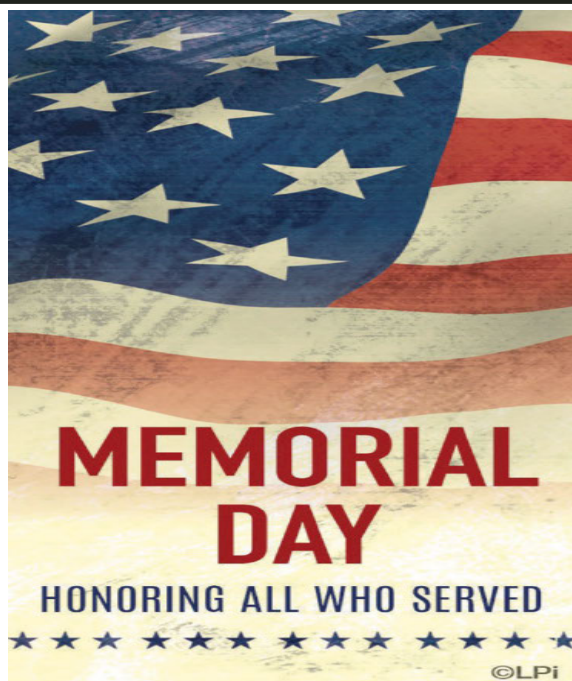


The names of the special men will be placed near the altar. Please ask an usher if you need a spiritual bouquet card to give to your father for your offering.

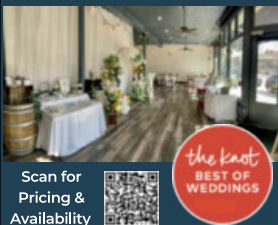

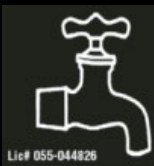

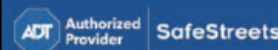
