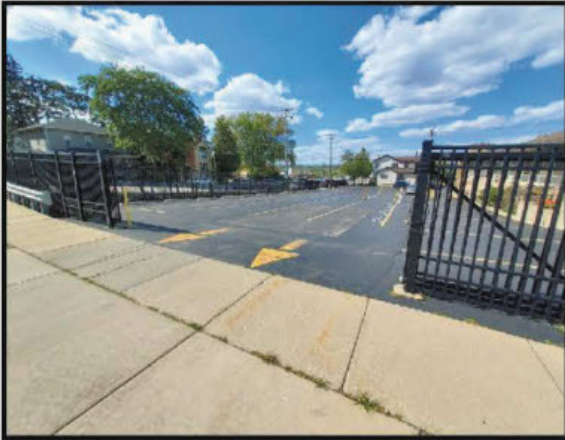

Go all the way around the back. Drop off will be at the two back doors.

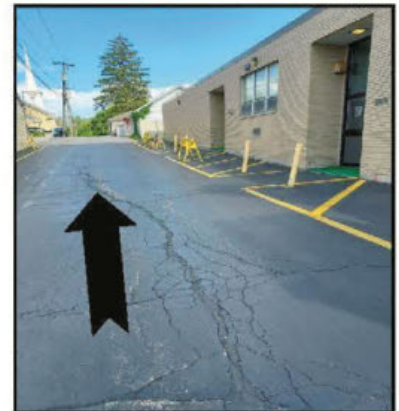
