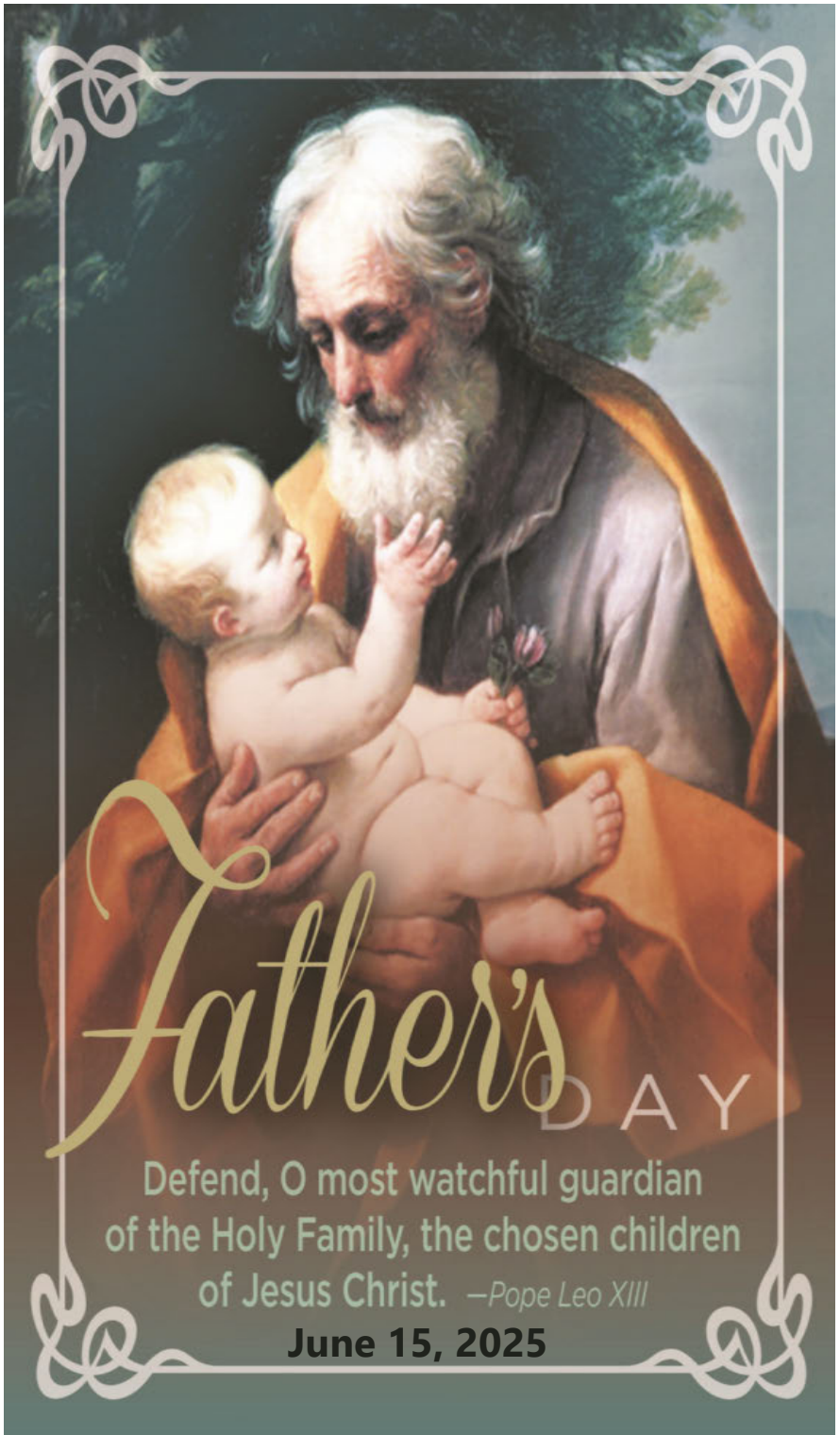

Holy Trinity



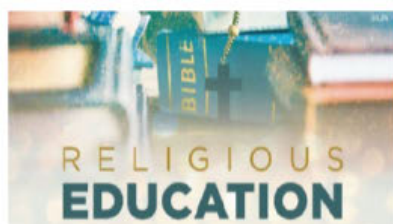



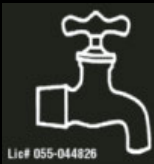
