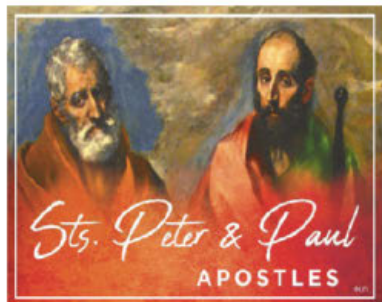

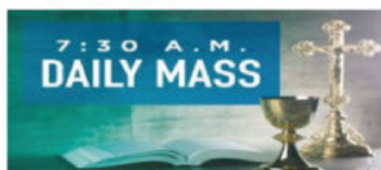
## Feast of St. Peter and St. Paul

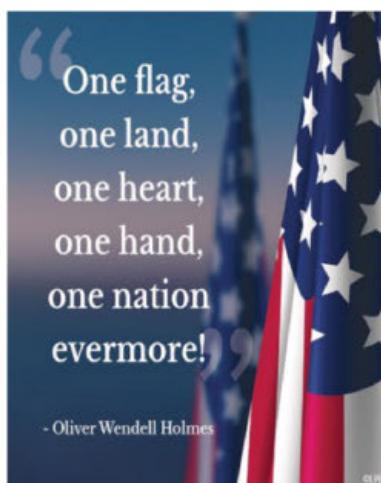

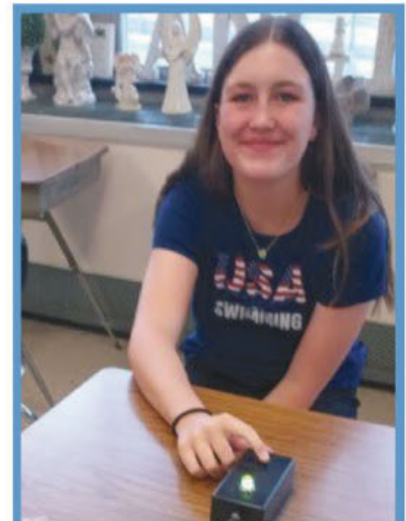
# Religious Education Update

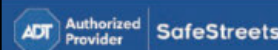
