






### Scripture Reflection



In today's Gospel, Jesus says, "light your lamps and be like servants who await their master's return from a wedding, ready to open immediately when he comes and knocks on the door. 

OCIA is a gradual process by which an interested person becomes a member of the Catholic Church. OCIA marks the various steps and rites on the way to full commitment with the church in five specific periods. This journey takes place over several months with the support of the parish community.




