



Scripture Reflection



In this weekend's Gospel, Jesus proclaims he "has come to set fire to the earth." This statement is very different to his frequent preaching of peace. What we need to realize is that, while fire is commonly associated with death and destruction, it also signals the beginning of new life. Consider a field that thrives under the action of a controlled burn. This process clears away debris and releases essential nutrients back into the soil so a new harvest will arrive. If we allow Christ to set fire to our lives, what would that fire burn away? What can we give him as kindling? Let us look into our souls and see where the fire of Christ can be ignited and pray that our souls may be consumed by its life-giving flames.


Order of Christian Initiation of Adults
