

### Ministry Fair





OCIA is a gradual process by which an interested person becomes a member of the Catholic Church. OCIA marks the various steps and rites on the way to full commitment with the church in five specific periods. This journey takes places over several months with the support of the parish community.

### Buckets of Hope 2025 Campaign
