




Exaltation of the Holy Cross

Religious Education Update

Classes begin October 1st. Drop off and pick up instructions are illustrated below. We ask that families with multiple children in the same session ask the oldest sibling to gather their younger siblings prior to exiting the building. In addition to the 'drive-up' drop off and pick up listed here, families may PARK on Cass St. and walk their children to the front door entrance (205 E. Cass). They may also PARK and pick them up here as well. *If using this option, please make sure your children know to meet you at the FRONT doors.*

Go all the way around the back. Drop off will be at the two back doors.




There will be 5-6 rows for cars. Choose a lane and pull all the way up. *(There will be someone there to direct you).* Once students are released from class, cars will be directed in a single file around to the back where students will be waiting.



Students will stand behind these barricades at the back of the building (where they were dropped off) until their car pulls around to pick them up.
