



## Scripture Reflection




Our fall sports season is coming to a close but our Celtics continue to make us proud both on and off the court!





In the Catholic Church the month of November is called the “MONTH OF HOLY SOULS.”

**ALL SAINTS' DAY – Saturday, November 1, 2025**

[ THIS YEAR ALL SAINTS' DAY is NOT a Holy Day of Obligation] Though there will be no mass held for this feast this year, we celebrate all those who, having passed beyond the veil of death, now live with God in heaven. This solemnity reminds us of the holiness to which we are all called.

**ALL SOULS' DAY – Sunday, November 2, 2025**

**The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed**

On this day (and at the vigil mass at 4 p.m.), we pray for those who have died but not yet fully entered the heavenly kingdom. Our love for one another continues beyond death, and we are united with one another in the hope of eternal life with Christ.

This year at our 11:00 a.m. Mass at St. Alphonsus Church, we will remember in a special way those who have been buried from our Parish in the past year. At the beginning of the liturgy, we will read the names and light a candle for each of these special people. We will also pray for all the souls who have gone before us.

**The BOOK OF THE NAMES OF THE DEAD**

will be displayed in each church from the solemnity of All Saints until the beginning of Advent. It is left open for people to write the names of their deceased loved ones and for others to read the names, remember, and pray for the repose of their souls. Remembering all of these men and women who have gone before us, “marked with the sign of faith,” helps us better understand and appreciate our faith in Christ our risen Lord who conquers sin and death and brings new life to all.
