




Christ the King

We thank you for the beauty and fullness of our land.


We thank you for our work and our rest, for one another, and for our homes.

Daily Morning Mass





Your dedication as a Catechist is an inspiration. Thank you for giving your time, patience and heart to help others grow in their faith.





For the last several weeks, inquirers (people interested in the Catholic faith), have been meeting with the OCIA team of our parish. During this time, they have explored their own faith journeys and whether the Catholic Church is the place to continue that journey.

For those inquirers, the Catholic Church holds special Rites: **The Rite of Acceptance and the Rite of Welcoming.**

This Sunday at the 9:00 a.m. Mass, we welcome Keri, Zach, Emma, Randall, Brandon, Melody, and Hope, as they seek the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation or to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church.

We, the parish, as the Church, are very important in this rite, for it is the entire Church – those in this community, as well as the entire Body of Christ beyond the walls of this parish – who surrounds them with special care, support, and prayers as they prepare to receive the Sacraments of Initiation.

We ALL are part of the OCIA program in our parish by being models of commitment to worship, by being examples of living our faith in service, and by being a body of believers who welcomes candidates into our homes, meetings, and services, and rejoices in the effort to integrate them into the Catholic family.




