## Safety Notes



As we embark on a New Year, I want to remind everyone about a few safety issues:

- 1) Before and following our weekend Masses, it is important that parishioners use the designated crosswalks adjacent to both churches. While some may be inclined to cross State Street by a different route, this practice may pose a significant risk to safety.
- 2) We are all aware of the limited parking availability in the Lemont area during weekends, particularly during winter months. However, it is crucial that we ensure that our parking lot entrances remain unobstructed during Mass times. Also, please be considerate of others and refrain from parking in designated "**No Parking Zones**". Our objective is to maintain clear access points for emergency vehicles to enter and exit.
- 3) Additionally, please be aware that the parking lot located to the west of St. Alphonsus Church (across State Street) is not designated as a church parking lot. The owners of this parking lot have issued a warning that they will report to the authorities any vehicles found parked there during weekend Masses.
