
## Warm a Heart Community Service Project

### BURNING OF THE PALMS

TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 17, 2026

AFTER THE 7:30 A.M. MASS AT ST. ALPHONSUS CHURCH

Where are your palms from last year’s Passion Sunday? The ritual of burning old palms for the ashes on Ash Wednesday is a reminder of our ongoing journey of faith. We held our palms high on Passion Sunday last year, welcoming Christ, our triumphant King, to Jerusalem. We burn these same palms, turning triumph to ash, symbolizing the times we fail to live as Christians. On Ash Wednesday, the dust of the ashes will be marked on our foreheads as once again we begin our communal journey to renewed faith at the Baptismal font on Easter.

Baskets will be placed in the narthex of both St. Patrick and St. Alphonsus churches for you to deposit your old palms. [Please remove any staples or rubber bands from your palms!] Please join us after daily mass on February 17, at St. Alphonsus Church for the Rite of the Burning of the Palms.

### FASTING

*Fasting helps deprive ourselves from good and bad things that are keeping us from devoting our hearts to Christ.  
It can deepen our awareness of Jesus' sacrifice on the cross.*

**Abstinence** from meat is required on **all Fridays** of Lent for Catholics 14 years of age and older.

**Fasting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday** is also required for all Catholics who are 18 years of age, but not yet 59. Fasting requires eating only one full meal on these days, and other foods as necessary to maintain strength.

### ALMSGIVING

*Almsgiving helps us to love others as Jesus loved us; to live our profession of faith not just through our words, but also through our actions to those around us each day.*


