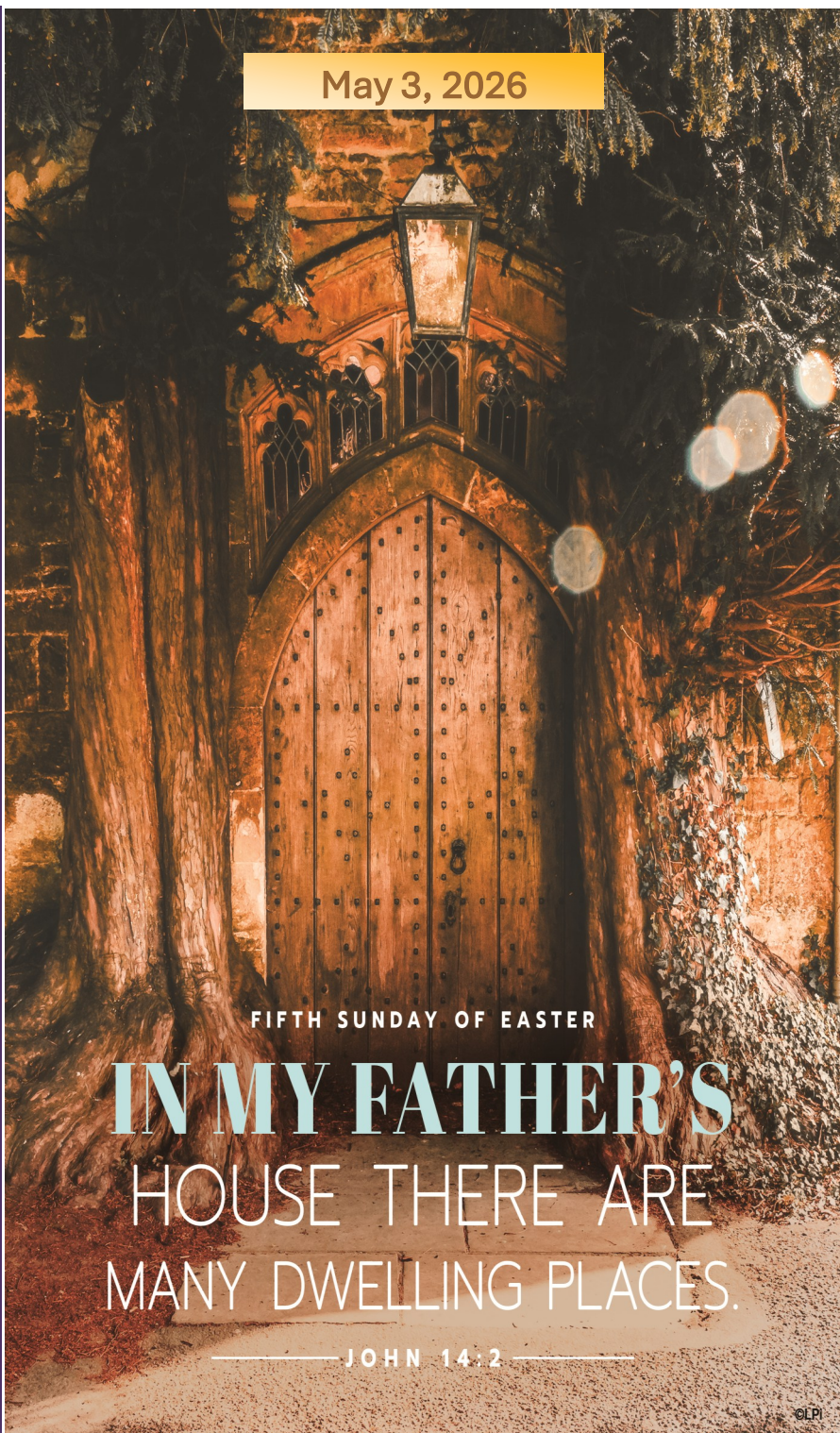

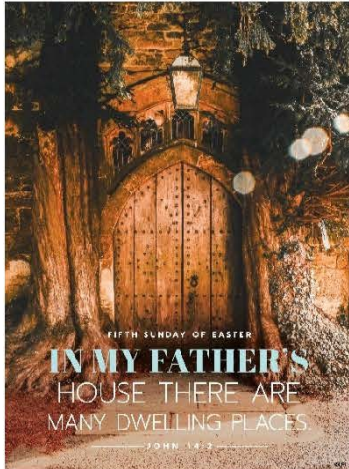

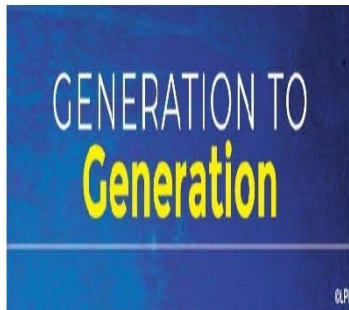
Scripture Reflection
