

From the Deacon's Desk:

How to Bless your home for the Epiphany.

The Epiphany house blessing of the door is a Catholic tradition for families. All you need is a piece of chalk!

It is traditionally done each year on the Solemnity of the Epiphany (also known as 3 Kings Day or Twelfth Night) done on the "lintel" of the front door of the house and uses symbols drawn with blessed chalk.

This tradition has biblical roots to when the Israelites put the blood of a lamb or goat on the doorposts and above the doors of the houses.

"The blood on the doorposts will be a sign to mark the houses in which you live. When I see the blood, I will pass over you and will not harm you when I punish the Egyptians." Exodus 12:13

The markings for this year are 20+C+M+B+23 The 3 letters are the first Initial of each of the kings (Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar). The "C, M, B also stands for the Latin blessing *Christius* Mansionem Benedicat which means "May Christ Bless this House".

Blessing prayers are on the table in the Gathering Space.



Let us remember in prayer Jean Lamers who have been called by God to eternal life. We also remember her family and friends, and pray that God will give them consolation and peace.

Sacred Heart Catholic School is excited to remind you that we are a part of the Wisconsin Private School Choice Program. The state of Wisconsin has three separate programs that allow eligible students to attend a participating private school (like Sacred Heart) in grades four-year-old kindergarten (4K) to 12. The private school, on behalf of the student's parent or guardian, receives a state aid payment for each eligible student.

Parents/guardians who want a faith-filled, academically challenging educational experience for their child/children, but may not be able to financially afford a tuition payment, now have the CHOICE to gift their child/children with a great education at Sacred Heart Catholic School! Through this program the State of Wisconsin pays for each CHOICE student's tuition, field trip costs, and school supplies. (Most students who qualify for Choice ALSO receive FREE meals through the Food Service Program). Once a student is accepted into the CHOICE program his/her costs are covered in full through the child's 8th grade year at Sacred Heart and through 12th grade at accepted private high schools! What an amazing blessing and gift!



For the 2023-24 school year, the family income of a student new to the WPCP must be at or below the amount listed in the table above for the program the student is applying for. All students must apply each year at dpi.wi.gov/choice.

"If a student is continuing (already received a voucher for the previous year) or was on the choice waiting list the prior year, he or she does not need to meet the new income limits, but does need to go to the above website and ACCEPT the voucher for the new school year.





Family income includes the income of the student's perential/legal guardianty) that reside in the same household as the student applicant. If the student's perential/legal guardians that reside in the same household are marked, their income is reduced by \$7,000 when determining income eligibility for the program (i.e. marked family income minus \$7,000 is the income amount marked families compare to the tables below). Family size includes perentiallegal guardians and their children by birth, markinge or adoption that reside in the same household as the student applicant.
